Practical thoughts for a productive day

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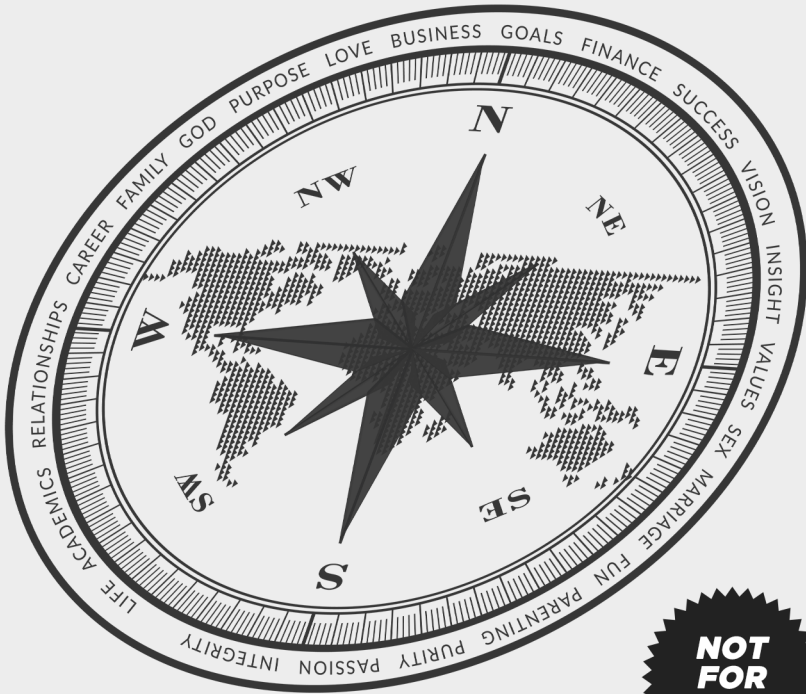
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Introduction

DAY 01

DEAR BELIEVER, BEFORE YOU MAKE CRITICAL CHOICES...

Text: Psalm 18:28-39 NKJV.

For You will light my lamp; The LORD my God will enlighten my darkness. For by You I can run against a troop, By my God I can leap over a wall.

My spiritual father would say to us that one of the most critical decisions that must be settled at the beginning of a vision is discerning the people to join in and those to refuse a placement. He further adds that "The people you don't pray in are those who trouble you the most".

The devil tries to wreck a vision in two major ways- Infiltration and Opposition. The devil's first choice in battle and warfare is infiltration. When infiltration fails. He goes for opposition.

When the enemies of Judah and Benjamin heard that the temple of the Lord was being rebuilt, they approached the leaders of the people and said to them, "Let us build with you, for we worship your God also. We have always sacrificed to him also" (Ezra 4:2)

It took a discerning Zerubbabel and other leaders to stop the infiltration. They told them, "You have no part in the work" (Ezra 4:3).

After infiltration, they tried to discourage and frighten the people of Judah so they could stop the work. They also bribed officials to work against them. That also failed (Ezra 4:4)

When opposition through others failed, they went into full-blown unhidden opposition. They used their strength and force to stop the building of the temple (Ezra 4:23).

You cannot afford to be a believer that lacks discernment. Prayer helps discernment. If your prayer life is weakened, your discernment becomes poor. The devil can succeed with penetration.

Simon the Sorcerer could have become the Evangelism and Crusade Coordinator in Phillip's Ministry until the visit of Peter and John revealed that he had the wrong heart and he was told that he had no portion in that ministry.

The snake penetrated the Garden by befriending Mrs Eve Adam. Hagar was groomed in Abraham's house. All the wood that Paul carried on the Island of Malta looked the same until the fire exposed that one of them was a snake. If you are not aflame, a snake can take the posture of wood and you will not realise it.

Invest in prayer daily but much more before you make critical choices. Jesus showed by example how he prayed all night before he chose the twelve disciples that he designated apostles (Luke 6:12)

A Christian is not a casual man. You cannot be making decisions casually. There will be times your spirit will be uncomfortable. Do not just shove it aside. That was how Paul unveiled the "he in the her" of the girl who kept following them (Acts 16:18).

Before you rejoice over that help, get on your knees. The breakthrough must not break down the marriage, family, business, career or ministry. Pray first!

DAY 02

CHANGE THE BATTLEGROUND

Text: Hebrews 12:11 NKJV.

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

My younger daughter would always contend with and pull things out of the hands of her elder sister. I watched them struggle over a balloon one evening.

She took it from her elder sister. Danielle burst into tears while Olive was smiling. Then Danielle did something. She took it back from her. She went to a bookshelf and placed it at a height that Olive cannot reach.

She smiled to herself and said, "You cannot get it from there". The balloon battle ended immediately.

Beloved, victory over the devil is not won fighting the devil on his turf. The only way you can defeat the devil is to take the battle out of his turf to a battleground where the devil's techniques do not work.

For instance, when the eagle and the snake fight, the serpent will win if the battle is on the ground but the eagle would pick up the snake and take it to a height that the snake loses its breath, and strength and then dies.

Also, in the battle of nations, the airforce comes in to destabilise a target by shell bombing it before a ground force goes in to finish the job.

Beloved, you cannot defeat the devil fighting in his way and using his style. Fear is the devil's turf. You win by faith and love. Worry is the devil's turf. You win by joy. Joy, Faith and Love changes the battleground. The devil loses orientation and then cannot comprehend let alone stand you.

How do you do this? Do not speak about the storm (you will be on his turf that

way). The disciples spoke of the storm and it did not cease. Change the game. Speak to the storm. Jesus did that and the storms obeyed.

When you begin to see physical attacks, it means the devil has lost the battle in the spiritual. He is only using his last strength to derail or distract you so he can defeat you. Stay sensitive!

Do not get angry. That's the devil's turf. Stay calm and sensitive. Confuse hell. Take the battle to heights he cannot comprehend. Imagine Jesus saying "Love your enemies". Enemies do not understand that game plan. He has no love in his arsenal.

Do not get weak. Use the airforce of prayer. Unsettle the serpent. Pull him to terrains he cannot explain. You are born to confuse hell.

The devil cannot win you in joy.

The devil cannot win you in faith.

The devil cannot defeat you on your knees.

The devil cannot defeat you when you walk in love.

Change the battleground!

You are more than a conqueror!

DAY 03

“SO THERE WAS FRIED RICE IN THE KITCHEN”

Text: Jeremiah 29:11 GNT.

I alone know the plans I have for you, plans to bring you prosperity and not disaster, plans to bring about the future you hope for.

It had been a pretty hectic day. It was also a day of fasting and prayer. As we returned home knowing we were already late, I told Irewamiri, “What are we eating tonight seeing we could not prepare our regular fried rice?” She said to me, “What would you love to eat?” I told her anything that would not add any more work load to the already hectic day.

As we got home, I went to meet her in the kitchen and said to her, “So Babe, what are we cooking?” As I looked to my right, sitting here there elegantly was a pot of fried rice”. She had played a prank on me. I did not know she had some time to make the meal earlier in the day. I gave her a huge hug.

There are two things that make up every great union: The first one is Love. The second one is Sacrifice. The Love of God to us is not even complete without a huge sacrifice of giving His son. You cannot talk about love without talking about sacrifice.

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 NIV

A lot of times we want to talk about loving without making any form of sacrifice at all. Any sacrifice that is made without love is a waste.

If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. 1 Corinthians 13:3 NIV

Second, there are things that will be revealed when we walk in love. There are things prepared for you that only love would reveal.

However, as it is written: “What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived”—the things God has prepared for those who love him— 1 Corinthians 2:9 NIV

There are things prepared for those who love God. Yes! They are things unseen, unheard and things beyond our imagination.

Hear me- Do not let the devil lie to you that your love for God is a waste of time. There are “pots of fried rice” that you have not seen, “well peppered meat” that you have not unveiled and there are “bowls of salad” that are reserved just for you.

God may take you on a journey to prepare you for it but it does not mean He will deny you of it. When He reveals it to you, it will be at the right time with inexpressible joy.

The waiting time is never a wasted time. At the end, the waiting will be worth it. Do not let your waiting season be hijacked by the devil.

Can you imagine I got angry because I thought there would not be fried rice? Even by the time I discovered the sacrifice she had made, the taste would not be amazing again. Be patient. God has great things prepared for you.

GIVE THOSE CLOSE TO YOU YOUR BEST

Text: Exodus 20:12 NIV

Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

Dad had some appointments to keep in Ibadan. He requested that I drive him. I agreed. At least, it is a privilege. We always get to have great father-son moments on the road.

As we got back to Eruwa, the first place we would get to was my house before his house. He asked if I would head to my place first then he will drive down to his house. It was not a big deal right? But then I asked myself if I was driving my Pastor or my Trainer, what would I do? That changed everything. I drove Dad home first and arranged for how I will get home.

Honour your father. Yes! Honour shows in simple things. Honour is not conditional. Honour your father even if he does things that you do not like. Honour means you place the right value on a thing or a person. Honour is very important.

“Honor your father and mother,” which is the first commandment with promise: “that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.” Ephesians 6:2 – 3 NKJV

Familiarity is terrible. There is a way that we treat those who are close to us. We keep the best plates for visitors. We take extra caution when we are with strangers. The meal is sweeter when there are visitors around. Familiarity is terrible.

Familiarity is costly. Milcah got too familiar with David. She forgot the king dimension of him. She despised the oil on his life. She spoke anyhow to a man coming home to pour out his blessings. She got the curse of a closed womb without David saying anything about her

state.

Sometimes, the answer you seek for the next level is locked up in how you treat those who are the closest to you.

Peter charged the men to dwell with their wives in understanding because it is key to answering prayers.

Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honour to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered. I Peter 3:7 NKJV

Familiarity will make you honour your pastor but despise your spouse. Honour is not selective. If you are a person walking in honour, it must show in all your affairs. Dishonour will keep you low. Dishonour will keep you in the same spot.

When next you have to serve those who are closest to you, ask yourself “Is this how I would treat my boss at work?” Give those close to you your best.

DAY 05

CAN GOD RELY ON YOU?

Text: Acts 13:22 NIV

...I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.'

A friend was narrating to her that she had an emergency some days back and sent a text message to some of her friends to kindly stand in the gap for her around 1 am.

She then asked her friend, "Why did you not text me also?" The friend told her, "It is difficult to reach you on a normal day let alone the day of an emergency. Everyone, I reached that late hour responded in a frame of two hours"

Beloved, Prophet Isaiah was talking about a nation that the Lord beckoned on and he said about that nation they responded swiftly and speedily.

"And will whistle for them from the ends of the earth; And indeed, they will come with great speed swiftly." ISAIAH 5:26 AMP

Prophet Isaiah has other things to say about them:

"No one among them is weary or stumbles, Nor one slumbers or sleeps; Nor is the belt at their waist undone [as if unprepared for action], Nor is the strap of their sandal broken. Their arrows are sharp and all their bows are strung and bent; Their horses' hoofs seem like flint and their chariot wheels like a whirlwind. Their roaring is like a lioness, they roar like young lions; They growl and seize their prey And carry it off and there is no one to save it." ISAIAH 5:27 – 29 AMP

They are not people sold out to weariness. They do not slumber or sleep when the Lord beckons. When He signals to you at 2 am, do you respond? They are always prepared for action.

How about their arrows? It is sharp. They are sharpshooters. They get answers in prayers. They have a voice. They roar. They pray until something happens.

The question is "Can God depend on you?" Can the Spirit of the Most High place a burden for intercession on you or does heaven have to look for someone else?

Anna the Prophetess and Simeon were

trusted with the intercession for the birth of Jesus Christ. Can God place such a task in your heart and you come through with it?

God said through Prophet Ezekiel that He sought for a man to stand in the gap but He did not find any. When Heaven asks, "Who shall I send?" Would you be able to answer, "Here I am. Send me".

The church is in critical seasons. We need men who will be stable in prayers. We must stop losing women because of birth complications. We must stop losing lives to terminal diseases.

The Apostles gave themselves to the ministry of the Word and Prayer. They had men who served and also people who gave. Today, both the priest and the flock are hustlers. The shepherd returns from work as tired as the sheep. The prayer cover is torn.

Mammon has driven us very far from high callings. We even subtly abuse "full-time" ministry. We teach entrepreneurship to men with high callings. We make them settle for somewhere in-between. They must survive. Elisha now holds on to his agriculture business and follows Elijah once in a while. Peter can no longer abandon fishing. While on the field, he is looking at the time and worried about the boats.

Can God rely on you at such a time as this? Can you be the Esther of this century? Can you be the Mordecai of this hour? Can you wait on the Lord so that sentences of evil will be reversed?

We need men with the heart of a warrior and the boldness of a lion. Can you be God's man? Will you get His text message? Or are you too busy?

I am not driven away by Mammon. I occupy my place in destiny. I am on the Lord's side.

DAY 06

HAVE YOU KNOCKED?

Text: 1 John 5:14 NKJV

Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

We were preparing to hit the road for the day. I was the first to get into the car. While I was settling down at the wheel, I heard a knock on the door at the passenger's side. It was Danielle.

As I opened the door, she said to me, "Daddy, I have been knocking on the door". I responded, "I opened it as soon as I heard your knock".

Jesus said to us, "Ask and you shall receive. Seek and you shall find. Knock and the door shall be opened unto you". It is a principle of prayer.

Do not assume that doors will just open unto you- knock on the doors. Do not assume that your needs will be met automatically- ask!

This was perhaps the error of the son of the prophet who died in debt and used his sons as collateral. He never cried out to the prophet. When he died and the problem he created was choking his widow, she ran to the prophet. The answer was in asking the prophet.

Prayer is not an assumption. Prayer is intentionally and deliberately asking, seeking and knocking.

Do not just assume that people are meant to help you. Assumption creates hurt.

Can you imagine someone standing at your door for about two hours without knocking? The person then gets angry when you opened the door to do something else. Would that not be weird?

Do not assume people know what you are going through. If you need help, ask for help. Do so without a sense of entitlement.

A lot of people walk our streets with a sense of entitlement. The truth is people only help you out of their volition. Do not become entitled. It is a privilege to be helped.

God is always willing to open doors for you but are you asking, seeking and knocking?

I am intentional about prayer. I ask the Lord in faith. I receive answers to my prayers.

DAY 07

I DID NOT SEE THE PLACE YOU ENTERED (The Power of Observation)

Text: Genesis 13:15 NLT

I am giving all this land, as far as you can see, to you and your descendants as a permanent possession.

I was attending a family function and a dear one was with me. During the event, I walked into the residence of a relative. For some minutes I did not see the person with me. When he eventually came in with another person, I asked, "Where have you been?" He said to me, "Pastor, I did not see where you entered".

One important thing about following is the power of observation. You must never get lost or distracted by many things that may be happening at the same time. Keep your eyes on the person that you are following.

Dear Christian, if you will not miss your way in following Christ, keep your eyes on Him.

One way to keep your eyes on Christ is by following those who are following Him. Paul admonished the Corinthian church to follow him as he follows Christ. Do not joke with following.

Paul wrote also to the Phillipian church that they must be observant before they can practice.

Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you. Philippians 4:9 NIV

You learn by teaching, association and observation. Observation is a critical part

of learning. Observation is a critical part of receiving also. Elijah told Elisha that the way to access what he has requested is by being observant:

"You have asked a difficult thing," Elijah said, "yet if you see me when I am taken from you, it will be yours—otherwise, it will not."

2 Kings 2:10 NIV

Poor learners and poor observers would not access great inheritance in this kingdom. Lessons and blessings will fly past men whose eyes and hearts are distracted.

In our Christian walk, you have according to what you see and not according to what is available. It can be available but if you do not see it, you cannot appropriate it. It is the "as far as your eyes can see" rule.

I am giving all this land, as far as you can see, to you and your descendants as a permanent possession.

Genesis 13:15 NLT

How far can you see?

DAY
08

"I CAN NEVER FORGIVE HIM"

Text: Matthew 6:12 AMP

*And forgive us our debts, as we have forgiven our debtors
[letting go of both the wrong and the resentment].*

Years back before ministry started, I walked out of my room after some moments of prayer and I had a word from the Lord for the first person I saw. I said to her: "The Lord said to say to you, "Your Life is just about to begin but there is someone you are refusing to

forgive".

She said to me, "I say yes to the fact that my life is about to begin but forgive that person, I can never forgive him". I asked her to speak to me and she poured out her heart.

She dated a young man with who she ended up doing all sorts and for quite unimaginable things. After the worst happened, the boyfriend dumped her and called her a rag. Just a few days before I saw her, he called to tell her he was getting married. She felt used. She cursed him, his marriage and his unborn children.

One of the things that will give the devil a perpetual grip on your life is an unforgiving spirit. If you realise that you keep struggling as a believer and you stay in the cycle of your past, you need to check if you are not keeping the property of the devil.

An unforgiving spirit is a fertile ground for sickness to thrive. A bitter spirit cannot produce the fruit of the spirit. If the devil succeeds in leaving the seed of an unforgiving attitude, he will return to check for the fruit that it will bear- bitterness and if not careful, diseases can sprout also.

The devil will always return to check if he has a stake in your life. Jesus said so:

I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me.

John 14:30 NKJV

The devil will always hang around anyone who has his package. Make sure that he has nothing in your life.

One of the major hindrances to answered prayers is an unforgiving spirit.

“And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses.” Mark 11:25 – 26 NKJV

Make sure you discard the devil's baggage. An unforgiving attitude is not a load the human spirit can carry, it is too heavy- you will break down eventually. There is a lot of wisdom in these three words- Let it Go!

“YOU WILL OUTGROW HIM”

Text: Matthew 6:12 AMP

But solid food is for the [spiritually] mature, whose senses are trained by practice to distinguish between what is morally good and what is evil.

I was speaking to a dear Sister some years back. I noticed her spiritual growth as her Pastor and I was excited about it. Every Pastor loves a growing sheep! I told her the truth about her courtship.

She had been talking about the man in some previous conversations. I told her,

“Can I tell you this? The pace at which you are growing, if your man refuses to grow, you will outgrow him. There will then be problems because you will not be talking about the same values or have the same understanding”.

It happened exactly like that. She fought for it but it dawned on her that their

values were not the same even in something as simple as consistent church attendance.

Friends, two things must play strong roles in your decisions in life: First is Growth. The second is Value.

Some of the troubles you will have will come from holding on desperately to people and places you have outgrown. Can you imagine at 25, you are trying to wear a shirt you loved wearing at age 10? No matter how much you try; it cannot fit.

Most “couple affairs” that began on campus (even fellowships) hit the rocks when one of the parties begins to outgrow the other or they realise that they were hasty in making a choice that will not fit the demand of their destiny.

You just realise that you love each other but your direction is no longer the same.

A second challenge will be your values. For instance, you did not know the importance of a local church on your life’s journey but now you are fiercely committed to learning, growing and serving in your local church but your immediate company are still full of “sleepers on service days” not to talk of commitment to serving.

You now realise that your destiny will not be built in a party but the place of prayer. The party has reduced. You now realise that you must be accountable to be responsible but you are in a company that laughs every time you say you want to visit your mentor or pastor.

You now realise that sex before marriage is a breach of the covenant but you are in a company that feels “What is the big

deal with having a little fun, at least we are adults or we are getting married?”

You have chosen the high road of purity but you are in the company of those who sit down to watch and discuss the latest in sitcoms, songs and styles that promote nudity and perversion. You all go to church but you see your taste is different.

Growth and Values will always be the demarcating lines in the long run. You will love them genuinely but you know that there are lines you will not cross.

You know the demands of your destiny and nothing will make you settle for less. You know you are on a national assignment with international impact, and you cannot afford a day’s rest in the bosom of a “burning beautiful housewife”. Your destiny will not allow it!

Let your values and growth be tied to the demands of your destiny.

Remember, when it comes to your destiny, be brutal. No sentiments!

May your head not find rest where your destiny’s demand will not be fulfilled.

My growth is not in contrast to my destiny. I imbibe godly values. I make pro-destiny decisions. I am helped by the Lord.

DAY 10

DON'T ALLOW OFFENCE TO THRIVE

Text: Matthew 11:6 NKJV

And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me

A dear father in the faith gave me an appointment to see him. I honoured the day but I sent messages to get further details. I got no reply. I had to travel back to base without seeing him. I sent some follow-up messages.

Some weeks later, I needed to send him another message when I realised that he sent me a message that I did not see. I was so shocked. I had to apologise. I told myself, "Thank God I did not walk the path of offence. I would have acted foolishly"

Certainly, offence will surely come. You must be the one that will refuse to be offended. Ensure you are also not the trigger of an offence.

Then He said to the disciples, "It is impossible that no offences should come, but woe to him through whom they do come!"

Luke 17:1 NKJV

As long as men relate, one issue or the other will come up but you must not just walk in forgiveness, you must walk in advanced forgiveness.

Much more than forgiveness, you must learn that "Love bears all things". Give space in your heart that deals with the challenges that come with relating with people.

Love suffers long and is kind; love does

not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

I Corinthians 13:4, 7 NKJV

Offences arise most times when you are quick to jump to conclusions. If you have not seen the full picture, do not form an opinion. Be patient. It may not be the way you think it is.

There are times as children when our parents flogged us, shouted at us and disciplined us without knowing the full story. They listened to an outsider and reached conclusions about our character and behaviour. Some of you still have that pain in your heart till now. Let it go!

But the big question is- Who are you treating the same way? Do you have the full picture of what your spouse actually did or it was what you were told? Have you given that friend the benefit of doubt? How about your business partner? Be patient. It may not be what you think.

I guard my heart against offence. I deal with issues with godly wisdom. I am a peace builder. I walk in love.

DAY 11

MA, THIS IS NOT THE AMOUNT I REQUESTED

Text: Jeremiah 17:5 NIV

This is what the LORD says: “Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who draws strength from mere flesh and whose heart turns away from the LORD.

My friend shared a story of how a random woman showed up at their door and asked his Mum that she wanted to see a Doctor. Well, she mentioned that she needed some financial assistance for her boy in school. He did not know her but went in to envelop an amount to support her.

A few minutes later, the woman returned and said to his mum, “Ma, where is that Daddy?”. The mum asked if all was well. She replied, “Ma, he did not give me the amount I asked for. The money is not complete”. The mum was in shock.

One of the things to kill is a sense of entitlement. Do not live your life like people owe you. There is a level when persistence begins to look like foolishness. No one owes you anything.

People who give you when you ask and when you did not ask are certainly doing their best. There are times they are giving you their last dime. You don’t know the season that people are in. Your perception may be wrong. Even if it is right, they do not owe you.

Gratitude is a virtue. Someone reached out to me once and asked to send a token. He sent me airtime of 200 naira. My God! I was so grateful for it. I did not thank him less than the person who gave me ten thousand naira airtime. I was massively grateful when I realised he was a missionary in a small village. It touched me more.

If you know the story that surrounds people’s gifts to you, you will be humble. There was a day I was sitting beside my daughter in the hospital and helping out someone with a knotty police issue at the same time yet someone else was still getting angry that I am ignoring her request for help. I only

smiled. Do not become entitled.

Entitlement is a trap that gets you into trouble. Adonijah had an entitlement mentality. Hear him:

Then he said, “You know that the kingdom was mine, and all Israel had set their expectations on me, that I should reign. However, the kingdom has been turned over and has become my brother’s; for it was his from the Lord. Now I ask one petition of you; do not deny me.” And she said to him, “Say it.” Then he said, “Please speak to King Solomon, for he will not refuse you, that he may give me Abishag the Shunammite as wife.”

I Kings 2:15 – 17 NKJV

He had a sense of entitlement to the throne. He did not get it. He now wanted Abishag. Solomon read between the lines. He gave him no room to ask for any other thing. That was his last request.

Adonijah should be grateful that after an act of treason, he was still alive. He crossed the line with a sense of entitlement. He paid with his life.

Dear Sir/Ma, deal with entitlement mentality. Do not let it wreck you.

God bless you!

DAY 12

"IT WAS MY TAILOR THAT MADE IT THAT WAY"

Text: 1 Corinthians 10:31 NKJV

Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

When I spotted what this daughter of Zion wore to the wedding ceremony, I asked her what happened that she wore such a revealing dress. Her answer was to blame her tailor. "Pastor sir, it is my tailor that made it that way. I did not see it until today". However, it was not too long afterward, that I realized that it was not the tailor, it was a pattern that she was gradually settling into.

First, every child of God must live in the consciousness of royal priesthood. A believer is both a priest and a king. When you gave your life to Christ, your identity changed.

But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light. 1 Peter 2:9 KJV

Let's take a cue from the priesthood of Aaron. Aaron and His sons were set apart as priests in Israel. It was an office they were to occupy. Do you know the first thing God mentioned after they were set apart as priests? It was their clothing:

And thou shalt make holy garments for Aaron thy brother for glory and for beauty. Exodus 28:2 KJV

God set the purpose for dressing right there: First, it must be for glory. Second, it must be for beauty.

But it did not stop there. Do you know that God literally prescribed the kind of "tailors" and "fashion designers" that can sew for the priest? Yes He did:

And thou shalt speak unto all that are wise hearted, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office. Exodus 28:3 KJV

Tell all who are expert, whom I have endowed with skill and good judgment, that they shall make Aaron's garments to sanctify him for My priesthood. Exodus 28:3 AMPC

Those who make cloths for priests must be

wise-hearted. They must be full of the spirit of wisdom.

Dear believer, if you claim that your tailor is the problem, well! God prescribed the type of a tailor a priest should use:

The tailor must be skillful. They must know their onions. They must be very good on their job.

But there is another requirement: The tailor must have good judgment. Next time get a tailor that knows that your breasts are not for display. Get someone that will not be saying, 'Except your breasts show a bit, the work will not show'. So you eventually got a wedding gown that does not look like your priesthood.

God had to emphasize it again and he gave his reasons for this: Their nakedness must be covered.

And for Aaron's sons thou shalt make coats, and thou shalt make for them girdles, and bonnets shalt thou make for them, for glory and for beauty. And thou shalt make them linen breeches to cover their nakedness; from the loins even unto the thighs they shall reach: Exodus 28:40, 42 KJV

God gave three simple conditions for the appearance of a priest:

For Glory

For Beauty

For covering of nakedness.

You are now a priest. Does your dressing represent you well? Or are you still blaming your tailor? Then change the tailor! Or change your heart. Repent!

CONFESSION

My appearance is not lust-provoking. My appearance glorifies God. My body is the temple of the Holy Ghost.

DAY 13

DOES PASTOR SEE YOUR STATUS?

Text: Philippians 4:5 KJV

Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand.

A member of the church was asking another member some years ago- Does the pastor see your status? Because if he sees this your status, I am sure by now you would have gotten a message from him!

What was the issue? She was indecently dressed with her cleavage out and she paraded it on her status.

Christianity and indecency are parallel lines- they will never meet. No matter how much you try to justify the fashion that exposes your body part, there is no scriptural backing for it. It is not Christ-like in any way.

You must begin to decide who defines your boundaries- fashion icons, secular music videos or the framework of righteousness as specified in the Word of God and by the Holy Spirit.

Is God interested in how you appear? Certainly. Right from the Old Testament, He prescribed what the Priests would wear. He gave two things that must be checked every time you dress up:

And thou shalt make holy garments for Aaron thy brother for glory and for beauty.
Exodus 28:2 KJV

The first question is "Does it glorify God and all that He represents in my life?" After you have settled that, you then must ask "Is it beautiful?" If it is beautiful to you but fails the first test of glorifying God, discard it!

Is Christianity promoting mediocre appearance? Not at all. Jesus told the story of a man who was kicked out of a wedding feast because he was not properly dressed:

"But when the king came in to meet the guests, he noticed a man who wasn't wearing the proper clothes for a wedding. 'Friend,' he asked, 'how is it that you are here without wedding clothes?' But the man had no reply.
Matthew 22:11 – 12 NLT

Once you are a child of God, you cannot appear just anyhow. Let your dressing glorify God!

CONFESSION

I glorify God through my appearance. I honour God in my dressing.

DAY 14

A GENERAL LIE TO "SAVE FACE"

Text: Galatians 4:19 NIV

My dear children, for whom I am again in the pains of childbirth until Christ is formed in you.

Some years back, I kept looking for the key to the car. I searched everywhere I could. I did not find the key. Then I decided to check the car itself. I discovered I had locked the key in the car. Fortunately, Dad had a spare. He gave it to me so I could retrieve the key but not without a warning to be more careful next time.

However, some days later I was looking for the key again. As Dad headed to work, I mentioned that I was looking for my key and I was sure I would find it. Well! I discovered I had locked it again in the car. Now, I knew where the spare key was. I picked up the spare key and returned it after retrieving the missing key.

Then my test came- the next morning, Dad asked, "Temi, where did you find your key yesterday". My answer was evasive. "Dad, it was just lying somewhere". He did not say a word but went on to work.

Then I lost my peace. As I settled at my desk in the ministry office. The Holy Spirit convicted me of lying because of the fear of being scolded. I picked up my phone and composed a text to Dad apologising for lying to him and telling him exactly what happened. My peace was restored.

Spiritual growth will happen as you pass your tests. Every time you evade your tests, you will remain weak in character. If you do not repent, it will become easier to make sinful decisions. The strength of your character will get weakened by the day.

At the initial stage, your conscience will ring like an alarm clock but if you do not respond and repent, your conscience

will snooze out on you while you carry on wrong-doing. You can do the wrong thing so often that it begins to seem right.

The Christian walk is a journey of "Fruitfulness". You must produce godly fruits. It is proof of maturity in the faith. If all we see are strange fruits, we will have to doubt if indeed you are a believer.

If you are loaded with gifts but lack fruits, you will be gifted but lack godly character. We need a revival of fruits now. When the grace of God unto salvation appeared to all men, it began a training curriculum for men saved by grace to learn to say "No" to unrighteousness. If you claim to be saved but cannot say "No" to sin, you certainly have been missing in the class taught by grace (Titus 2:11,12)

I grew up seeing an art piece in our living room that says, "If you are accused of being a Christian, will there be enough evidence to prove it?" That statement stuck with me.

Can my colleagues testify that I am a Christian? What testimonies do my neighbours have? If my phone (my gallery, and my playlist) is called on to testify about my Christian virtue and character, what will their testimony be?

I know we are all work in progress. Kindly let us see the progress! Where is the proof?

GET SET FOR MIRACLES YOU DID NOT SEEK

Text: 2 Corinthians 3:5 NKJV

Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God.

Some months ago, we were having an appraisal meeting about our weekend service. There was a time during the service when the generator went off. It was not the first time it was happening. No one spoke about it because we knew we had a lot on our table.

The head of the technical team just said, "Pastor, we would need a new generator". We all smiled. I said to him, "you already know our scale of priorities for projects. Kindly ensure the generator is repaired". We ended the matter there.

The following day, someone reached out to me. After exchanging pleasantries, the question he asked shook me to praises and awe of God- "Pastor, I know you have been on a building project. We thank God for it. Does the church need a new generator and what is the cost?" He said, "I just perceive to ask". The next day, we had the funds for a new generator.

When You did awesome things for which we did not look, You came down, The mountains shook at Your presence. Isaiah 64:3 NKJV

Paul introduced God to us in a very amazing way. He said He is the God who can do far more than we can think. True!

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, Ephesians 3:20 NKJV

If you have gotten to a point where your calculation cannot provide the answers, you are in a great spot for God to show His area of specialty- Impossibilities.

"Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?" Jeremiah 32:27 NKJV

Do not shut down. Faith does not put a limitation on God. God will never put a limitation on faith. He does miracles.

Read this again:

When You did awesome things for which we did not look, You came down, the mountains shook at Your presence. Isaiah 64:3 NKJV

God will do mighty things that you did not look for today. Amen!

DAY
16

DO NOT LET SHAME KEEP YOU BACK FROM OBEDIENCE

Text: Hebrews 12:25 AMP

See to it that you do not refuse [to listen to] Him who is speaking [to you now].

We were attending a conference. Right after the Word session, prayers began. It was so intense. At that moment, the Lord told me to walk to the altar and kneel. I hesitated for minutes. Why? How can I be all dressed up, and sitting in a special area in the church do such a thing? Why would I allow people to look at me like I do not understand the “protocol of decorum and organization”? I just cannot!

Well! I eventually broke protocol and went to the altar. I held on to the base of the altar as I prayed intensely. By the time I was leaving the altar, I realised some others have joined me there.

Beloved, obedience will come with sacrifices. Obedience is always a sweet-smelling savour to the Lord. It breaks through the limitations of our humanity and connects us to the blessings of the Lord. God loves acts of obedience. He sees it as worship.

Second, there are times when you are not the only one that God is speaking to. If you delay in obedience, someone else can take your place. Late obedience is no longer a sweet-smelling sacrifice. Obedience must be prompt and complete. Some people got to the place they were sent and they realised that the work had been done. They have been replaced by another obedient son of the Lord.

Third, your obedience is always a pattern breaker. There was no one at the altar when I obeyed the Lord but others joined after I stepped out. God can use your obedience to challenge others. I know people who have caught the spirit of boldness to go to the place the Lord has called them to because they saw what

obedience can do through the work in Eruwa here.

Before the woman with the issue of blood touched Jesus and got her healing, everyone who got healed before then was touched by Jesus. But after her, many started making attempts to touch Jesus. Some were even challenged that they told Jesus to just speak a word. But do you know she had to despise shame? Do you know she fought her fears? God used her as a pattern breaker.

There are times when we are too composed and packaged for the Lord to move. Our “shell of protocol” is so thick that the sword of the Spirit seems not to be able to cut through.

A dear father in the faith went for the groundbreaking of a major project that would take years of construction. As they finished giving thanks, God told him to lie on the floor in Thanksgiving. He obeyed. He did not mind the size of his suit. The Lord told him, “I have taken over this project now”. They built it in months. The same has happened to me once also. God took it over. He did what no man could do.

Beloved, are you too packaged for God to move to obedience? Deal with it. God is always far from proud. Who is waiting on your obedience? Or will you be replaced?

CONFESSION

I prioritise obedience to God's prompts at all times. I am not held down by protocols or people's perception. I walk in obedience to God.

“SO I WOKE UP LATE AGAIN”

Text: Psalm 22:30 NLT

Our children will also serve him. Future generations will hear about the wonders of the Lord.

Just as we were about to head to church on Sunday morning, Danielle asked me, “Daddy, we have prayed, right?” I said, “Yes we prayed at 5.30am but you were still sleeping”. The next thing she said shocked me, “So I woke up late again”. I was awed. Her definition of waking up late was missing family devotion. Her awareness stirred something in me.

A child will be careless if parents do not lay a solid foundation that teaches the importance of keeping to time. Indiscipline is also learnt.

Having a consistent time of family devotion can be your child’s first home training on the importance of timing.

You cannot just pray at any time that is convenient as a family. You are raising the next generation to be careless without knowing.

There are days you pray at 6 am, at other times, you just rush devotion in the car and on Saturdays, you wait for everyone to wake up before you pray. We should not mention many days that there are no family devotions.

Dear young couple, develop the habit of praying together as a family before your seeds begin to arrive. Personal devotion should not replace family devotion. Each has its unique role. Pray together!

Dear parents, you are training an entire generation- you cannot joke with that responsibility. For some of us, our first Bible training school was family devotion. It taught us the word but it also taught us the discipline of time and the power of consistency.

Once a child is becoming aware of timing, maturity is already taking place. A man that does not value time is a child locked up in adult skin. A child that understands time is a man locked up in baby looks.

One of the great virtues for building a great life is the discipline of time and consistency. Great nations value time and do not joke with consistency. Go and check out nations that are underdeveloped and their attitude when it comes to time and consistency.

Dear parents, you are raising nations. Jesus developed awareness early in life. He knew there was the business of His Father. He had a consistent habit of fellowshiping in the Synagogue. He also stood up and took responsibility. There is no doubt that Mary and Joseph played great parental roles also.

Joseph was keen on hearing and obeying God promptly. Mary was keen on doing the will of God.

If God wants to bless the world with a great seed, would God gladly use your family?

DAY 18

THE PRESSURE THAT THE BILLBOARD BROUGHT

Text: Galatians 6:14 NLT

As for me, may I never boast about anything except the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. Because of that cross, my interest in this world has been crucified, and the world's interest in me has also died.

The first time I would drive through a city and spot my image on a billboard was in 2016. As a young minister, the feeling was different. It felt like an accomplishment. I even wanted to keep a picture of it.

The next time I would have such an experience was five years after. I got calls and messages from people residents in the city or wayfarers who knew me that they saw my image in the city.

But something happened: Months afterwards, I was back in the city where the protocol was amazing and hospitality was top-grade. I wanted to stop by a restaurant where local dishes were served and then I remembered that I had been on billboards. The pressure rose.

I reminded myself, "Temi, do not have a bloated image of yourself. Go and eat your Amala in peace".

One of the traps of "branding" is the pressure to keep up an appearance. You have to keep feeding the self-developed perception. If you brand excessively, you can lose touch eventually with who you are and the processes that should have shaped your character and helped your journey.

Is branding bad? Not at all! But when it begins to drive you to the extreme of pretence, make-believe, and ego, you need to deal with it. Take your steps in life with patience.

Have you noticed that if you have ever been on the radio or television, it almost seems as though everyone should know you? It is not true. Most of the pressure you are trying to live up to are self-

imposed.

You must understand the seasons.

You must understand the reasons.

You must be guided by kingdom lessons.

You must not live your entire life building a pack of lies to defend another lie.

The process is still a part of life's journey. Own the process. If the conference was not full, do not use images that only make it feel so. Own the process.

Can God be using you to kill the lion and the bear and you keep quiet about it until the day the testimony is needed? Or will you have huge pictures of the "lion-killer"? Can your heart preserve the move of God? Can you discern your quiet seasons and enjoy them?

Please build inner fortitude and values first. They will become your map when you want to derail.

DAY 19

“WHEN YOU TRAVEL OUT, 90 PERCENT OF YOUR PRAYERS ARE ANSWERED” – STATEMENTS THAT PROMOTE LUKEWARMNESS

Text: Leviticus 6:12 AMP

The fire on the altar shall be kept burning; it shall not [be allowed to] go out...

I was having a meeting with a couple of proteges and I focused on those who had left Nigeria for other nations. As we interacted over their spiritual growth, one common trend to all of them was “Pastor, our prayer life is not as strong as before”. I knew something was not right.

It took some weeks but a statement some people make struck me differently. You hear people say it when they describe the “prayerfulness of Christians” in our nation. What is the statement? “When you travel out, you will realise that ninety percent of your prayer points are answered because they have a system that works”.

There are people whose prayer altars are now gathering dust. They find it hard to pray, fast or study. In the worst-case scenario, some have abandoned what they call “this God thing”.

Friends, if your prayer life dips because you are now in a place where your needs are met, there is a challenge with your doctrine of prayer. Remember, the doctrine is the regulator of character.

That assertion is based on the premise that “Prayer is transactional”. Most people go to God because of their needs. If prayer is basically because of your needs, you will stop praying once your needs are met.

It is the “lost son” syndrome. You will go to the father saying, “Give me”. Once you get it, you forget the father. The only time you remember the father is when there is another need. It is a transactional relationship.

But prayer is more than transactions. Transactions are fine. At least Jesus taught us to ask for “Our Daily Bread”. He taught us to ask for “Deliverance from Evil”. But remember that was never the starting point.

Prayer is first and foremost relational and not transactional. Even when I have all the bread and I am delivered from “road accidents”,

and “armed robbery” because I am now in a system that works, I do not forget that prayer is about:

- **OUR FATHER**- This points to a relationship. He provides. He protects. He heals. He delivers. But the finest revelation you can have of God is that He is our Father. I pray because I have a Father with whom I love to relate with.

- **HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME**- This points to reverence. Even if all my needs are met, I pray because I revere Him. I adore Him. I know what it means to honour and fear the Lord.

- **YOUR KINGDOM COME**: This points to the royal life of a believer. I am a prince of God’s kingdom. There are a lot of things that do not look like the culture of His kingdom. I stay in prayers to see souls saved, saints edified and revival breaks out wherever He has planted me.

- **YOUR WILL BE DONE ON EARTH**: This is God’s desire and it must be your drive. It is not everything in your vicinity that looks like the will of God. Why don’t you pick up a list of those things and pray? Comfort has closed down churches. Picnics have replaced prayer meetings. Nudity is driving out modesty. Witchcraft is disguised as prophecy.

Can you see that prayer is not just transactional now? If you stop having prayer points because you are now in comfort, you are already defeated. Comfort can be a form of persecution that kills passion for the Lord and His will. Deal with it.

CONFESSION

DAY 20

YOU DID NOT WASTE YOUR TIME

Text: 1 Corinthians 7:20 NKJV

Let each one remain in the same calling in which he was called.

We were in a camp meeting and I sat in between two Pastor friends. My friends were moved to the front row while I was left in the same spot. They were given words of knowledge while I got nothing.

Thoughts began to come to me: “You are not that important”, “You wasted your time to come”, “When you will stay in a place like Eruwa. You should have started in the city. Maybe you would have been known”. I rejected all the strange thoughts.

After the meeting, the guest minister spotted me and said to me, “Do you know you are a great man? Focus on the work the Lord has given you”. He also said some really specific and accurate words.

First, in the season when you are taking stock, remember that it is not a competition and you are not in a game of comparison. Focus on what the Lord has done in your life and be grateful for it. It must be a season of thanksgiving and not that of complaining.

Second, make sure you stay focused on the assignment of your life and destiny. While looking at the future, do not change lanes because of what you see others do. Stay in your lane. Stay where you were assigned. Men may applaud you for making a smart move while heaven looks down and calls your move a foolish one.

Men were leaving Saul. Samuel was delaying. Anyone who looked at it would say Saul did what was right by making the sacrifice. It was more than just making a sacrifice- he made his way out of the throne. He lost it all.

King Uzziah also thought that in greatness, he could decide to do things as he wished. He got served leprosy in the process. It

was not his bit. It was not his assignment. It was not his role.

Do not rush!

Do not jump around under pressure.

Do not become sad because it is not moving.

Be calm. What are you grateful for? Are you at least making progress?

Do not murmur. Do not be ungrateful. Rather than saying, “So this is how this is how I entered the new month without me having a new job...”, focus on the privilege of even thinking that you need a new one. Thank God your mind is in place.

This is what Paul said:

Do everything without complaining and arguing... Philipians 2:14 NLT

And He said again:

Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God’s will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:16 – 18 NLT

And do not compare. Rather, give thanks:

But they, measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise. II Corinthians 10:12 NKJV

DAY 21

HE LOST THE DESIRE FOR DRUGS...

Text: John 15:3 NKJV

Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you."

He had spent some of his teenage years living in a Pastor's house. He felt he was being choked. Once he got the freedom to step out to school, he slid into sex and drugs. He was getting into gambling. He had seen one of the popular foreign musicians as a role model. He wanted to look like him no matter the cost. He was a low-budget version! His life was a mess.

He had to be withdrawn from school. He found his way into the church. He would come to church and return to his drugs. One good thing was that he kept coming. He said once that his body would be shivering with a desire for drugs even while in church.

But one day, he left the church, as usual to go smoke some of the stuff. That day everything changed. The desire to quit was suddenly overwhelming. He could not smoke his hemp. It felt strange. Something had died on his inside. Constant exposure to the Word of the Lord has changed his story. He also got baptized in the Holy Ghost and that was the beginning of a new life.

First, life has no meaning without the Lordship of Jesus. A sinful life is not a free life. Stop thinking sinning is the freedom to do what you want. No! A life of sin is a slave of the devil. How do you know you are a slave? You can not stop of your own volition. Just try to stop using your will. You can try for some days but you return to your indulgence. Sin is slavery.

A sinner is a servant of sin- "But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin..." Romans 6:17 KJV

Second, sin wants to have dominion even over the believer but constant exposure to the Word of God is what makes it impossible for sin to rule over us. No

matter what, make sure you are constantly exposed to the Word of God.

The Word of God is your defence against sin. When sin tries to penetrate your life, it can only be resisted by the Word. David said that we must hide the Word of God in our hearts if we will not sin against the Lord. In every temptation of Jesus by the devil, Jesus had to reply with "It is written". Keep the Word in your heart.

The Word of God is a cleansing agent. It cleans us up.

that he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, Ephesians 5:26 KJV

By the Word, spots, wrinkles and blemishes are dealt with:

that he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. Ephesians 5:27 KJV

If you stay long enough with and in the Word, your life cannot remain the same. Do not let the devil lie to you to stop staying around the Word and studying the Word because your case is bad. He is a liar. The Word works. That addiction will bow to the Word. Stay there! Do not leave the church. Stay there.

You will be free!

DAY 22

WHAT EXCITES YOU?

Text: Romans 14:17 KJV

For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

We were driving out of a shopping mall when we heard the sound of some loud music that was blasting from speakers placed outside. Irewamiri looked, ate and said, "I cannot imagine getting excited at this type of music". Strangely, it was her comment that even made me realise that music was being played- my spirit did not pick it at all.

Whatever excites a man has a root in his heart and is a stakeholder in his decisions in life and destiny. Whatever excites you or gets your heart will succeed in moving you.

Men have been moved into God-ordained destiny and at times, destruction simply by the things that excite them. Your ears are gates into your soul.

You padlock your gates to strangers but open up your soul to strange things. You spend so much on physical security but so little investment in securing your heart- you are not smart!

Let me ask you: What excited Jesus? What excited Paul? What excited Peter? What excited the early church? If you think their lives were boring, you have not touched what they touched.

Jesus forgot food when He saw a soul that needed to be harvested. Paul said "None of these things move me". It was the gospel that moved Paul.

Have you been singing with friends before and you got so lost in worship that you were not aware time had gone so fast? Have you been on knees before in prayers and realise that four hours look like forty minutes?

Excitement thrills and when not well managed, it kills also. Beware of what excites you- is it an agent of life or an agent of death?

Your craving can lead you astray. Beware what you crave for:

"...it is through this craving that some have been led astray and have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves through with many acute [mental] pangs."
1 Timothy 6:10B AMPC

What excites you can lead you astray. Beware of what gets you excited.

Following Christ is not boring. If it is to you, you have not met Christ. Maybe, at best, you know religion.

CONFESSION

I do not expose my soul to anti-destiny things. My heart is guided. I find excitement in the Holy Ghost.



DAY 23

“GOD HAS CALLED ME BUT...”

Text: Hosea 13:13 MSG

When birth pangs signaled it was time to be born, Ephraim was too stupid to come out of the womb. When the passage into life opened up, he didn't show.

I could see that worried look on his face. He has the call of God into ministry but he has the fear of survival written all over him. He said, “Pastor, I will go on to do other things. I will come back and answer the call”.

My response was simple, “Running is not a big deal. You will still fulfil the assignment in a measure when you return but there will be just one challenge – You will not be running with your generation and do not think you will come and occupy the same spot in destiny. Another will run with this vision. God in His mercy will still give you something to run with”.

Truth may be hard but today he is running and he is very fulfilled.

The calling of God can be like the waves of an ocean- you cannot make the waves, you can only ride them. If you miss the wave of the season of your calling, you will have to wait for another.

Anyone that Jesus called and did not respond missed a wave. Such would have seen Peter and others in the early church and remembered how he missed out on a season.

To everything there is a season, A time for every purpose under heaven:
Ecclesiastes 3:1 NKJV

Your purpose is timed. There is a season when a man cannot run again. When the whistle of the track master

blows, it is better to have a headstart than have a false start or a late start!

Your assignment on the track of life is to take your position, stay alert for the whistle of the Lord and maintain your track till the end. Once the direction is determined, the next thing you ask for is speed. The joy of the race is that “There is no competition”. We run together but not against one another.

If you know God has called you, we are no longer in the season of excuses and delays. Your sentiments have kept you back for the past 10 years. When others are celebrating the anniversary of obedience to God's call, would you be celebrating the anniversary of delay and disobedience?

Grace!!!

You will not be found wanting when heaven is counting men who became kingdom soldiers by obedience.

DAY 24

“I WANT TO SEE ANGELS”

Text: Acts 6:4 NIV

And will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word.

It was an era when a lot of people were sharing things about the spectacular. My friend also desired to see angels and have all the vibes that come with it. He was hungry for it.

One day, he went on a prayer walk late in the night. Suddenly, he saw a lighted figure ahead of him. He had goose pimples all over him. At last, he will have an encounter! He prayed harder.

When he eventually got close to the perceived “angel”, it was a bent pole that had a lighted advert of one of the telecommunications companies on it. He was disappointed.

A sincere desire for the spectacular can become the trap that leads you into falsehood. Be hungry for the supernatural but beware of the spectacular.

Be rooted first in the Word of God. The Word of God is supernatural. A lot of people who do not read the Word of God begin to read meaning into dreams and visions. They chase the subjective without being rooted in the objective.

Every other experience must be tested by the Word of God- be it visions or

dreams. Do not let anyone lord it over you with visions and dreams that are not consistent with the Word.

The early church and the apostles devoted themselves to the Ministry of the Word and Prayer. They definitely saw miracles.

Don't be hungry for the spectacular when you are not hungry for the Word of God. Many victims of falsehood were first victims of ignorance.

Don't let anyone lie to you.

Do not let anyone deceive you.

Be a great student of the Word of God.

Test all spirits. Hold firm to the Truth of the Word.

Be hungry but do not be deceived.

CONFESSION

I am not obsessed with the spectacular. I thirst for the supernatural. I am rooted in the Word of God and in prayers.

DAY 25

“OLIVE! OLIVE!! OLIVE!!!” (The Cries of a Loving Sister)

Text: Galatians 6:2 NLT

Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ.

We were all in front of the church preparing to go home when Danielle shouted, "Olive. Olive. Olive". I wondered what the matter was. Then I noticed a church member carried Olive. They were walking away from the car to take care of some children.

Danielle thought they were taking her sister away from her. She screamed and called our attention to it.

It tells me about how powerful brotherly love should be: Take advantage of every opportunity to be a blessing to others, especially to our brothers and sisters in the family of faith! Galatians 6:10 TPT

If you are a Christian, you must have the love of a brother and the watchfulness of a soldier- not just over your own needs but over the needs of others who are part of the family of faith.

When you see your brother or sister in the faith getting carried away by other things, talk to the Father on their behalf and scream lovingly to get their attention.

You must not be too busy with your life that you forget to extend a hand of care to those who are burdened and broken!

Maturity takes your eyes from just yourself and your own needs- it broadens your view. A mature believer sees beyond his own needs as he ministers to the needs of others. Maturity broadens your heart.

David and his men lost a whole city but they were kind enough to minister to the need of an Egyptian slave. Peter had a

horrible day at work but he still offered his boat (without showing attitude) to Jesus.

Maturity is understanding that kingdom service goes beyond your mood! Maturity says, "God I may not have all I desire to have but I am still and will always be available for you".

When you are just engrossed in yourself and your needs without paying attention to kingdom assignments, Jesus would look at you and ask, "Do you love me more than these?"

Is there someone around you that you need to pray for today?

Is there anyone that used to be regular in church but does not show up again?

Is there someone that you know who has been hurt and offended?

Is there someone you need to scream his or her name today?

Be a brother.

Be a soldier.

Get kingdom attention on that person. Let it start with you!

I am committed to the welfare of others in the fold. I am available for kingdom service. I am my brother's keeper.

26**

"PLEASE, JUST TAKE ME HOME" (A gentle reminder on marital honour)

Text: Romans 12:10 NLT

Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other.

When I was done mumbling through my unprepared lines asking her to marry me. Without taking a look at me, she said, "Please, just take me back home".

I had driven her out with the alibi of helping her to mark and record examination scripts but I actually was asking her out. I was not sure whether she was shocked or amused. Her face was straight.

Few months after, she told me that, "I wanted to insult you that day. I was annoyed that I had placed you as my pastor on such a high pedestal but you descended so low and asked me out".

Then she added, "Every time I thought about giving you a piece of my mind, something within me could not. I wanted to but I could not insult you. I now know it was the Holy Spirit".

One of the important keys to a successful marriage is honour. Honour is celebrating the strength of your spouse without stumbling over their weakness.

Honour is keeping shut and talking calm even though your blood is at boiling point because you simply cannot shout on him or her.

Honour means saying "I am sorry" when you are right. You can air your position when the thick clouds are cleared.

Honour is fleeing all appearances of

fornication or adultery because of what you share.

Honour is protection from 3rd party unkind opinions even when it costs you a lot.

Do not marry someone that you are always quick to insult. Do not marry someone you cannot "fear" in the best sense of it. Do not marry someone whose weaknesses are the butts of your joke.

If you honour her, you will not spend all the time with friends and simply come home for sex. She deserves to be listened to, cuddled, loved and played with and helped too. You married a wife- your mind must be with her at all times (Stop viewing all manners of shapes and sizes).

If you honour him, you would not have exposed all his weakness to your gist committee and then smile "innocently" when you see him.

In marriage, honour is a must. Marriage is honourable so the spouses must be also.

I walk and live with my spouse in honour. Honour flows in all of our activities and decisions.

27**

WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN THERE IS A DELAY? (Part 1)

Text: Hebrews 10:35 NLT

So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings you!

One of the things that a believer must handle wisely is delay. Delays can lead to discouragement

and discouragement can lead to bad decisions. So, what should I do when there is a delay?

First, be sure you are not misinterpreting the season.

Moses was on the mount taking instructions for the Israelites. They were right there at the base of the mountain misinterpreting Moses's dealing with God as a delay that they cannot bear.

Second, do not let haste make you lay down your gold for idols.

God while giving Moses the template for the building of the tabernacle told him that the first thing the people would give would be "gold".

"Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring Me an offering. From everyone who gives it willingly with his heart you shall take My offering. And this is the offering which you shall take from them: GOLD, silver, and bronze. Exodus 25:2-3 NKJV

Unfortunately, the people were already laying down their gold as raw materials for idols.

Now when the people saw that Moses delayed coming down from the mountain, the people gathered together to Aaron, and said to him, "Come, make us gods that shall go before us... And Aaron said to them, "Break off the

golden earrings which are in the ears of your wives, your sons, and your daughters, and bring them to me...And he received the gold from their hand...and made a moulded calf. Then they said, "This is your god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!" Exodus 32:1-4 NKJV

Every time the devil succeeds in making you interpret divine workings and dealings as a delay, be rest assured that he is already stealing something from you.

In the name of Jesus, whatever is in your hands that heaven will use to produce a lasting impact in your generation will not be hijacked by the devil for his own agenda.

Do not forget, if the devil succeeds in telling you divine working and dealing is a delay, he is already stealing your gold.

I do not revoke my testimonies of God. I reject the devil's interpretation of my season. I am firmly rooted in Christ.

28

WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN THERE IS A DELAY? (Part 2)

Text: Hebrews 10:35 NLT

Patient endurance is what you need now, so that you will continue to do God's will. Then you will receive all that he has promised.

I wonder what was going through the mind of Joseph as they walked him into the prison- "God, is this my dream? This is not what I saw". As the doors shut down the light from outside, Joseph must have had to draw light from within.

What do you do when there is a delay?

Make sure you wait for God! I wish I could say that a thousand times. Alternatives lengthen the journey. Wait in worship. Watch your attitude. Follow

divine initiatives. Submit to training.

The disciples made this mistake at a point.

"That evening Jesus' disciples went down to the shore to wait for him. But as darkness fell and Jesus still hadn't come back, they got into the boat and headed across the lake toward Capernaum." John 6:16-17 NLT

Sometimes when you are waiting for

God, darkness will fall. Don't be in a hurry to take things into your hands. Without God, you will run into a storm.

"Soon a gale swept down upon them, and the sea grew very rough." John 6:18 NLT

It never takes long before we realise the folly of our haste. Don't marry in a hurry. Don't scream, "I am 30. I will have to settle for anyone now". Stop that. Do not walk into a storm.

Whatever you start by effort will definitely be sustained by effort. Your mind is too small to navigate the path where the Spirit of God should take the lead.

The disciples kept moving for three miles. They struggled in the storms. Nothing changed until they saw Jesus.

No matter how stormy it is, Jesus will always come for you. He will never leave you even when you did not wait for Him.

But you have a role to play also: Get him back into your boat.

"Then they were eager to let him in the boat, and immediately they arrived at their destination!" John 6:21 NLT

Did you see that? The moment Jesus was back in the boat, the storms were irrelevant, they did not toil at rowing again. Immediately, they arrived at their destination.

Stop struggling with the storms. Get Jesus back in the boat. Be humble enough to ask Him for help. You cannot do it by yourself.

CONFESSION

I stay with the Lord. My strength is renewed always. Storms do not alarm me. My peace in Christ is intact.

29

COMMITTED FROM DAY ONE

Text: 1 Corinthians 4:2 AMP

In this case, moreover, it is required [as essential and demanded] of stewards that one be found faithful and trustworthy.

Once we opened ministry office, we would resume daily in the office fully decked- shirts, ties and suit. People would accost some of the staff then and ask, "What do you people even do in that place? We thought it is a church". They never believed that the church should demand that level of seriousness.

If there is anything God has committed into your hands, you must give it all the commitment it demands- hold nothing back. A garden not watered would not produce effectively. When the garden is full of weeds, it would be an object of

ridicule rather than a blessing to many- it is same with a vision.

Paul mentioned that we are who we are by the grace of God. The grace of God is not an excuse for laziness. It would be a combination of divine direction and your input of hard work and diligence that will bear great visions.

Many have divine inspiration and vision but lack the diligence required to make it to great heights. Do not desire what you are not willing to pay the price for.

If you are called into the work of ministry,

know that the calling is work- serious work! Do not become the reason why people associate ministry work with mediocrity.

Do the work- whether a calling or a business as though you are in any multinational. Give it your best. Wake up early. Get to work early. Set daily goals. Build systems. Learn from those who have gone ahead. Be accountable. Be serious with the work. Be committed from day one. Follow through. Be resourceful. You will end up shining.

In the name of Jesus, you will never be small. Grace will colour your efforts. Limitations are shattered forever. You cross new lines. You produce outstanding results. Amen.

30

THE POWER OF DAILY ROUTINE

Text: Hebrews 10:11 NIV

Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

It was a bit tough getting the consent of my wife's siblings- they could not imagine that their youngest sister would return from serving the nation to mention that she wanted to settle in Eruwa and marry a pastor there.

One of the questions that I had to answer one of the days that I was given access and privilege was, "Temi, please describe your day to us". It was a test to know whether I was lazy or I knew what I was doing. The answer got me some headway.

There is hidden victory in your daily schedule. You can never do more than your daily routine on the day of crisis! When challenges beckon, it will expose what you have been doing daily.

For instance, the early church had a daily routine of commitment to prayer: "All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer." Acts 2:42

NLT

When crisis hit the church and Herod began to pick on pillars to eliminate them, their daily routine became their weapon in crisis: "Peter was therefore kept in prison, but constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church." Acts 12:5 NKJV

The challenges of life will always expose your daily investment. When Goliath screamed, David brought out his stone and his sling. He had mastered the use of the sling. He had mastered the use of the sling. It definitely was a part of his daily routine. He used in battle what he had mastered in training. He used in crisis what he had mastered as a daily routine.

If you do not sing daily, you will find it hard to sing in crisis. If you do not confess the Word daily, you cannot speak the Word in the middle of a crisis. If you murmur daily, you will murmur in the middle of crisis also.

Champions are groomed by their daily routines. They only display what they have mastered in the ring!

What are you committed to daily?
That will be your weapon when crisis also hits!

I am intentional about daily practices for destiny fulfilment. I am not confused and haphazard. I am blessed in my daily endeavours.

31

“WHEN I WAS “TOASTING” YOU, WAS IT STRESSFUL?”

Text: Romans 5:5 NIV

And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

Recently, Irewamiri took a trip to Lagos. We got chatting when she was returning and I asked whether I should pick her up in Abeokuta. She asked me, “Would that not be too stressful?”. I did not know when I said to her, “When I was ‘toasting’ you, was it stressful?”

It is so easy for the human mind to forget commitment and become familiar. You must train your mind not to slip into familiarity. Familiarity kills the flames of intimacy.

There are marriages now that has slipped into familiarity. The husband no longer treats the wife like a queen and the wife no longer attend to her man like a king. The man does not go the extra mile for the wife again. Now the meals are casually served. It does not matter even if it is cold.

It is also same as the relationship of some with the Lord Jesus Christ. The prophet Jeremiah had this to say to the nation of Israel:

“Go and cry in the hearing of Jerusalem, saying, ‘Thus says the Lord: “I remember you, The kindness of your youth, The love of your betrothal, When you went after Me in the wilderness, In a land not sown. Jeremiah 2:2 NKJV

The statement would have been a testimony except that it was all in the past- they went

after God but not anymore. They had lost the passion they used to have. They used to go after God but now complacency has taken over their commitment.

When you are in such position, just one thing becomes instructive-

But I have this against you: you have abandoned the passionate love you had for me at the beginning. Think about how far you have fallen! Repent and do the works of love you did at first. Revelation 2:4-5 TPT

You need to get that groove back. You need to get the passion back. Your fellowship with God needs new flames. Blow away the ashes and let a new spark return.

Do the same for your marriage- plan deliberately for your spouse. Do something that you used to do when the flames of romance were still quite hot. Give a treat. Offer to do something. Go the extra mile.

In the name of Jesus, the flames of love in your fellowship with God will come aglow. I also pray new passion into your marriage. Amen.

I keep the flame of intimacy in my marriage ignited. The love of God floods my marriage. I grow in love for God and His kingdom.



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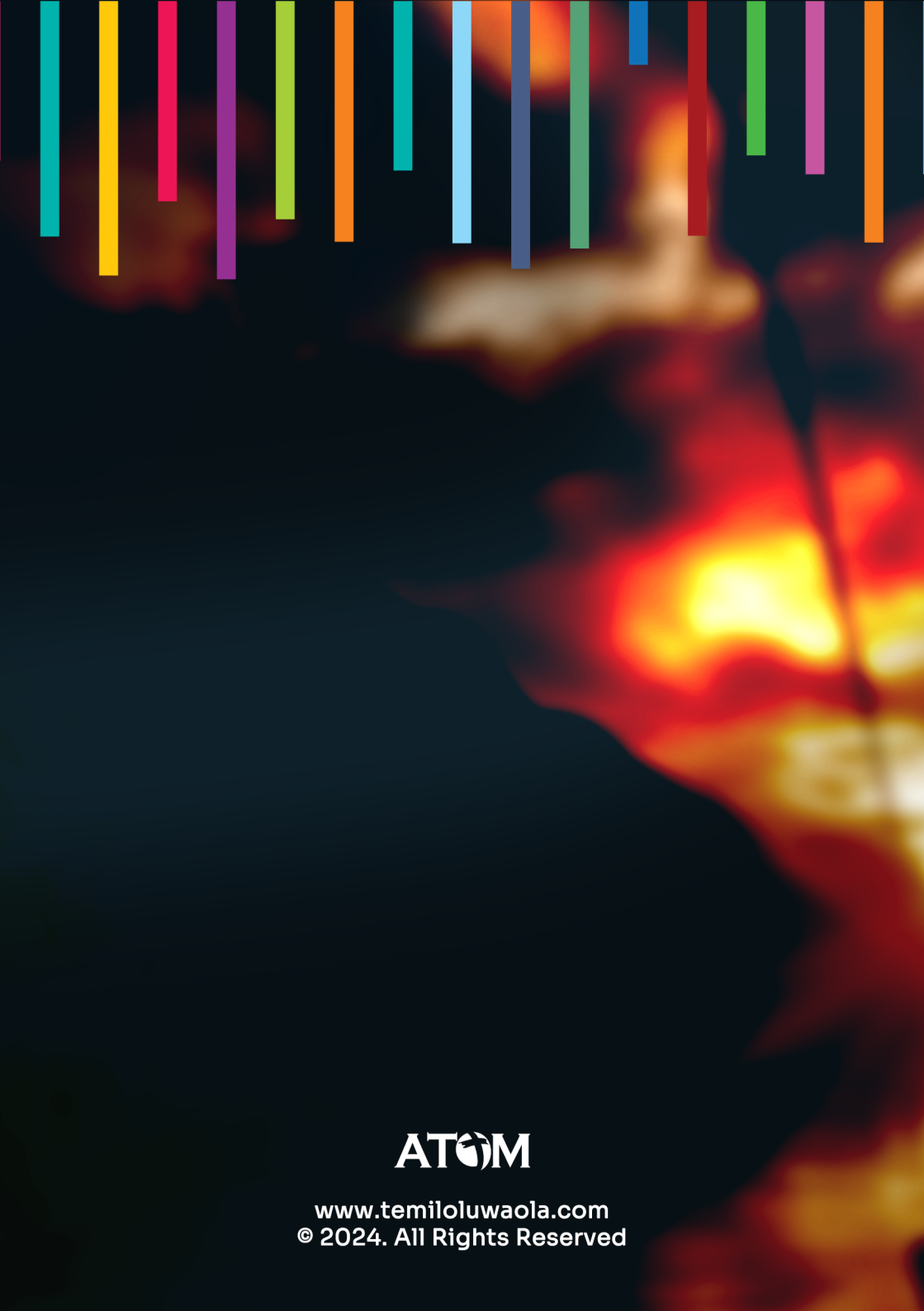
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
