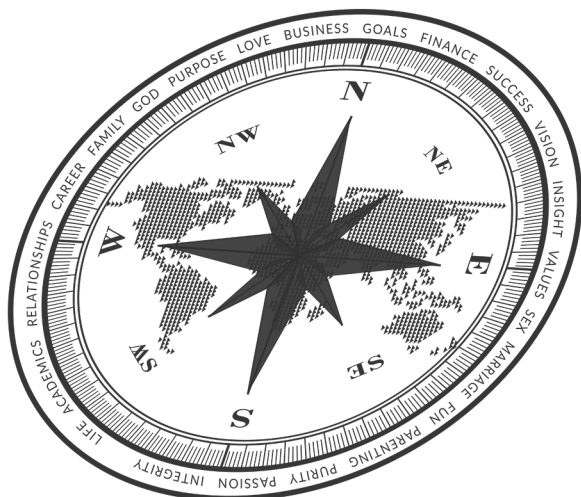

Text: Psalm 13:6 NKJV

I will sing to the LORD because He has dealt bountifully with me.

Psalm 34:1 KJV

He had a pattern of dancing with all his might:

2 Samuel 6:14 KJV
And David danced before the LORD with all his might; and David was girded with a linen ephod.

He praised the Lord in ways others thought that he was losing it. He did not care. He said I will do it even more.

2 Samuel 6:20 NLT
When David returned home to bless his own family, Michal, the daughter of Saul, came out to meet him. She said in disgust, "How distinguished the king of Israel looked today, shamelessly exposing

himself to the servant girls like any vulgar person might do!"

David's response was simple yet instructive:

2 Samuel 6:21-22 NLT
[21] David retorted to Michal, "I was dancing before the Lord, who chose me above your father and all his family! He appointed me as the leader of Israel, the people of the Lord, so I celebrate before the Lord. [22] Yes, and I am willing to look even more foolish than this, even to be humiliated in my own eyes! But those servant girls you mentioned will indeed think I am distinguished!"

How should you give thanks?

First, do it for the Lord. Dance before the Lord. Be conscious that it is for Him. Consciousness helps your attitude.

Second, do it in reflection of His goodness to you. Think deeply about what the Lord has done and what He will still do. Celebrate before the Lord.

Finally, be willing to look foolish before the Lord so He can make you look good and great before men. If you package before the Lord, you will lose that tiny reputation you are trying hard to protect.

God gives more grace to the meek. Do not let your heart be lifted in pride. Praise Him when He desires it and how He desires it whether it is convenient for your ego or not.

Will you praise Him shamelessly today?

TAKE NEW TERRITORIES PROPHETICALLY

Text: Joshua 14: 12 NKJV

Now therefore give me this mountain, whereof the LORD spake in that day; for thou heardest in that day how the Anakims were there, and that the cities were great and fenced: if so be the LORD will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, as the LORD said.

For a while, we decided to spend time praying for the influence of the church to extend to one of the sectors of our community. It had been a battle for almost four years. We took it seriously in intercession.

A few weeks into interceding, the barriers began to crumble one after the other. We began to see tangible results in that area. Folks began to come to church and get serious about discipleship in the church also.

Friends, prophetic fulfilment follows prayerful commitment. If we are not committed to praying, we are not ready to see the fulfilment of the prophetic.

You cannot possess new territories by simply wishing for them. You take possession first in intercession. Intercession must birth action.

When Moses was wrapping up his work as the leader over Israel, he said to them what the Lord said to him:

“Beginning today I will make people throughout the earth terrified because of you. When they hear reports about you, they will tremble with dread and fear.”
Deuteronomy 2:25 NLT

We definitely cannot doubt that Moses picked those words in prayer. He was a praying man.

Those words were fulfilled in the days of Joshua. Joshua sent spies into Jericho and Rahab made a confession that shows prophecies birthed in prayer will always be fulfilled.

“I know the Lord has given you this land. We are all afraid of you. Everyone in the land is living in terror. No wonder our

hearts have melted in fear! No one has the courage to fight after hearing such things. For the Lord your God is the supreme God of the heavens above and the earth below.
Joshua 2:9, 11 NLT

Dear believer, take praying seriously. Use prayer to build a bridge between the prophetic and its fulfilment. Use prayer as the steering wheel for a generation that you will necessarily not be a part of. Pray until you see what looks so hard and difficult become possible.

Pray to give the divine permission to permeate the affairs of humanity. Leave nothing to chance. Study data, discern patterns but do not explain them away. Take it to God in prayer.

Today, every barrier is removed. Your influence is enlarged in the name of Jesus.

Text: Matthew 8:8 NIV

The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed..."

While preparing for the Feast that month, the Lord said to me that "He would be taking care of long-standing issues". I believed and declared it. I had a prompt to take testimonies before teaching.

A seventeen-year-old stepped up to share. He said, "I came to the Dominion Feast at Fullness Conference. When you asked that we raise our desire to the Lord, I had just one".

He had a strange infection in his private part. He said it has been like that since he became aware. He would have to sleep naked and face the fan most of the time.

He said, "That night I cried to the Lord. From then till now, the strange infection dried up, and I can walk freely and sleep soundly".

His testimony was the catalyst that triggered a shift in the atmosphere at the meeting that month.

Beloved, there are times when we have desired a miracle and an answer for years, and it seems like we should no longer bother. Do you remember the woman with the issue of blood?

Mark 5:25 NKJV
Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years.

Twelve years. Wow! What happened in those 12 years? She saw many doctors. She spent all. The matter grew worse. If there was anyone who should throw in the towel, maybe she should have.

But 12 years later, her desire to be healed was so strong that she said, "Jesus does not have to touch. All I need is to touch him, and I know I will be made whole".

Mark 5:27-28 NKJV

[27] When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. [28] For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."

The proof of desire is pursuit. She stepped out. She got her healing that day.

Mark 5:29 NKJV
Immediately, the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction.

Twelve years!

The devil is wicked.

What is worse than being oppressed or afflicted? It is losing the desire to be made whole.

No matter what, do not lose the desire to be made whole at all! No matter how long you have waited, do not give up.

Today, in the name of Jesus, every long-standing issue is dealt with. All protracted illnesses are healed.

Do not kill that desire!

TRUST THE PILOT

Text: 2 Timothy 1:12 NKJV

For I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

We were travelling by air and it was raining just at the point of landing. It was a bit turbulent as we descended. I told my brother by my side, "Can you imagine that we trust the pilot to get us to the ground safely even when we cannot see him?" He got the message. No one was running around. However, you could see the tension in the faces of some.

In tough times, you need to trust God even when you cannot see Him. If you are not the pilot of your own life, you need to rest in the massive hands of the Lord. If you know that you did not bring yourself this far, then you should rest in the one who has brought you this far.

The challenge comes when you think you can actually take over the driver's seat and get yourself a safe landing. What's my point here? You do what you are meant to do. Let God do what only He can do.

Worry wants you to hijack the wheels from God when you are meant to trust Him. Trust means "active obedience". Trust is not just sitting down and looking. Trust means you follow every instruction in the middle of the crisis even when it does not make any sense.

Worry would hint to you that Moab is better than Bethlehem. It will make you hustle without the hand of the Lord. If worry hijacks the wheel, it can hinder the will of God. Refuse it.

How do I refuse to worry?

First, know that God is not harassed by your cares. Trust Him.

Second, stay in worship. It helps your heart to focus on how great the Lord is and not how huge the challenges are.

Hear the words of Peter:

So, humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time he will lift you up in honour. Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.

1 Peter 5:6-7 NLT

One way to humble yourself before the Lord is by giving your worries and cares to Him. It simply means that handling it yourself by worrying is pride. Let God handle it.

DISTRACTION, A SILENT KILLER OF INTIMACY

Text: 2 Kings 4:29 NKJV

Then he said to Gehazi, "Get yourself ready, and take my staff in your hand, and be on your way. If you meet anyone, do not greet him; and if anyone greets you, do not answer him; but lay my staff on the face of the child."

I did terribly as a young husband. One evening, I returned from work, and as my habit was, I picked up my phone and began to press it. I did not know Irewamiri had called me three times in an attempt to tell me something. I was so distracted that I did not know when she left our bedroom to another room. When I went to meet her, she was already angry about the whole thing. I had to start apologizing.

You can only sustain intimacy if you are focused. Distraction is a deadly weapon that has killed the flames of many relationships. There are distracted believers. They are children of God, but they have no focus on him. It is hard to sustain a time of prayer and study. Whatever distracts you have already conquered or defeated you.

In marriages, some men are so distracted that they do not notice the changes in their spouses. They do not notice when they make new hairstyles. They do not notice when they need their attention. Attention stolen is affection lost. You cannot sleep beside a sobbing spouse unawares. Wake up!

Some are distracted by work. In a bid to make ends meet, you lose the touch you have with your home. Be careful. Calm down. You need to find that strong balance. Create time to rest and get refreshed. Do not get lost in the chase for survival that you lose what you already have.

A distracted husband can wreck an entire household. The distraction of David began a downward slope that caused great issues at home. He had sons that he did not correct. One ended up raping his sister. The second killed the rapist and planned a rebellion. The

third that was never corrected almost staged a second rebellion. His home was a huge mess.

A distracted spouse is a ticking time bomb. It slows down the growth of the marital union. Focus on the Lord and draw strength to focus on one another.

I repented that evening. I went to her and began to apologize. She did not accept my apology and kept pushing my hand away. I did not get angry.

Listen! It is manipulative to be wrong and still be angry at the same time. It is terrible. Why would you be the offender and still be angry? You have turned your anger into a tool of manipulation. Stop it. Change that pattern.

What is affecting the intimacy you have with God?

What is affecting your intimacy with your spouse?

Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.
Matthew 19:6 KJV

Beloved, it is a man who can put asunder. If you are that man, repent!

IT HAS BEEN A WHILE I HEARD YOUR VOICE

Text: Psalm 55:17 NKJV

Evening and morning and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud, And He shall hear my voice.

As I lifted my voice in prayers, in less than five minutes, I heard the Lord say to me in a loving tone, “It has been a while since I heard your voice”. It sank into my heart. I knew what the Lord was saying. I was getting overwhelmed with activities and I lost touch with fellowship.

Even if you are called to ministry, you must constantly remember that the “work” must not replace the Lord. It is possible to be committed to the work and not committed to God. It is possible to go for Him and not go from Him.

There is a chain of intimacy that must never break. Ministry must be an overflow of an intimate relationship between you and God. You must settle it fast that fellowship is priority. There is nothing else that is fruitful if it is not done from fellowship.

Look at the structure of how Jesus called the disciples and let us learn from it:

***And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him whom he would: and they came unto him. And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach,
Mark 3:13-14 KJV***

First, He called them to Him. Your calling is first to God. Love him. Spend time with Him. Adore His presence. Do not joke with the fact that he called you to him.

Second, He ordained that they should be with him. Did you see the word “Should”? It means being with him is a priority. It is compulsory. That is your life.

Third, “And that He might send them out”. Did you see the word “Might”? It means it is a probability. If He has not sent you, calm down and simply be there with Him in prayer, worship, study and learning. The chain of intimacy must never be broken.

When you break the chain of Intimacy, frustration will set in. You will begin to use schemes to get results. Your goals will become self and no longer God or the kingdom. You must refuse it.

I prioritize intimacy with God. I sustain the chain of intimacy. I give myself to fellowship with the Holy Spirit.

PRAYER IS NOT TOO MUCH

Text: Luke 18:1 KJV

And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint.

As we began to pray, I said to my team in the ministry “This feels so good”. I then added that it had been a while since we had prayed together. As I mentioned that, I began to ask myself why.

It struck me that the challenge was that the hours of congregational prayers had increased as instructed by the Lord for the year. But I learnt a major lesson that “prayer is never too much”.

I wondered how much Moses and Samuel prayed that in Jeremiah’s prophecy, the Lord said that even if Moses and Samuel stood in the gap for the people, he would not need their cry.

Then the Lord said to me, “Even if Moses and Samuel stood before me pleading for these people, I wouldn’t help them. Away with them! Get them out of my sight!”
Jeremiah 15:1 NLT

Do you know what Samuel the Prophet called prayerlessness? Sin! That is how seriously Samuel took a lifestyle of prayer.

Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the Lord by ceasing to pray for you; but I will instruct you in the good and right way. 1 Samuel 12:23 AMPC

Would the results of Samuel would then be surprising? He began to hear God at a young age. God bypassed the priesthood of the day to speak with him. The nation of Israel waited on Prophet Samuel for a Word. None of His words fell to the ground.

He was used by God to institute monarchy in

Israel. He prophesied kings to the throne and prophesied a king out of the throne. What was his secret? Prayer is not too much!

Let no one lie to you that you are “over-praying”. In prayer, be patient enough to receive spiritual intelligence that you will deploy in whatever your hands find to do.

As I was praying, Gabriel, whom I had seen in the earlier vision, came swiftly to me at the time of the evening sacrifice. He explained to me, “Daniel, I have come here to give you insight and understanding.”
Daniel 9:21-22 NLT

A man who truly prays must be a man of insight and understanding. Daniel surely was that type of a man. Do not think you have prayed too much. We must not stop praying. After praying, we pray again. Even in the execution of God-given plans, we do not cease to pray.

Let nothing reduce your prayer hour- not even corporate praying! Pray in church. Pray on your own.

PRAY IN MEN, PRAY OUT MEN

Text: Numbers 22:9 NIV

God came to Balaam and asked, "Who are these men with you?"

I was in the office just some six weeks after I stepped into Eruwa to answer the call of God into full-time ministry. Every vision needs men even though I did not know it in this manner then but God showed up faithful.

A dear one whom I had known from my teenage years walked into the office and mentioned it was his birthday and God said he should come and see me. The rest today is history. He is also working with me full-time in ministry.

There is nothing God has committed into your hands that you will not need to pray men to join the vision and pray out some men who will want to hinder the vision. You must begin to do it very early in the vision.

The devil attacks the vision from infancy also. Herod told the wise men that he wanted to also worship the newborn king. The plan was not to worship. The plan was to terminate the programme of redemption. Divine plans were bigger than demonic moves. However, it took a sensitive father and obedient wise men to outsmart their scheme.

The easiest time to infiltrate a vision is always when it is still at the commencement phase. As the visioneer plants, the enemy will also want to add his seed. You must reject the seeds of the enemy.

The devil fights first by infiltration and not opposition. Even when the Israelites left Egypt, there was a category of the

huge exodus that was called the mixed multitude. They joined the movement from the beginning.

The Psalmist gave us an example of prayers to pray in this regard:

Send thine hand from above; rid me, and deliver me out of great waters, from the hand of strange children; Whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood. Psalm 144:7-8 KJV

There are strange children. They are vision destroyers. They do not build with you but are ready to tear down whatever you are building. May you enjoy the gift of discernment.

Before anything starts – ministry, business, career, marriage or whatever it is, remember to pray in men and pray out men.

HOW TO KEEP YOURSELF FROM FALLING

Text: Jude 1:24 GNT

To him who is able to keep you from falling and to bring you faultless and joyful before his glorious presence.

I did about eight months in a State University and I knew that every seed that my parents planted in me as regards the fear of the Lord was under intense attack. I was surrounded by various vices that could derail a teenager leaving home for the first time.

In those eight months, I had the opportunity to drink alcohol, get loose sexually, get lost in lust and many other things.

There was just one thing that kept me sane. I travelled home at least once a month. It was a solid reminder of where I was coming from and who I am. I may not have grown so much spiritually but it kept me from falling into a slimy pit.

One of the strategies of the devil to get a man into sin and keep him in sin is isolation from fellowship with God and men who can hold him accountable.

Before Judah married a Canaanite and slept with his daughter-in-law (thinking it was a prostitute), there was a departure from his brethren.

It came to pass at that time that Judah departed from his brothers, and visited a certain Adullamite whose name was Hirah. Genesis 38:1 NKJV

A man who will fall would first take a walk away from all eyes that can probe or ask him questions. A man who will fall will begin to distance himself from fellowship and friendships of accountability. When he begins to skip meetings, trouble starts

brewing.

If you have a job that takes you constantly from home and your home church, you need to double up on your accountability structures. Create a mode that will ensure the bridge is not burnt. Be generous with information. Join a circle of believers early anywhere you are.

If you travel out and you need to leave your family for a season, make sure you do not say things like, "At last, I can rest from church". That is the mindset that the devil is attracted to.

If you lose touch with home, you will likely forget your home training. Beware!

Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, And to present you faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, Be glory and majesty, dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen. Jude 1:24-25 NKJV

WALK THE PATH OF HONOUR

Text: Romans 13:7 NIV

Give to everyone what you owe them: If you owe taxes, pay taxes; if revenue, then revenue; if respect, then respect; if honour, then honour.

At a point on the journey of ministry, there was a situation that was hurting. I knew I could not stay in love, but it was equally tough to express love.

I was arriving in town, and I drove by the office of someone who had hurt me at a point. The Lord said to me, "Turn and bless him with the cash that is on you". That was strange. I was hesitant but I obeyed the Lord. It was not the easiest of all obedience then I must admit.

Greatness will always do what is right. Greatness will always tow the path of honour. Greatness will never undermine those who are deserving of honour or that it has been commanded to honour.

There are tests you are facing today that are simply your audition for greatness. If you are not obedient and courageous enough to tow the path of honour, you will be eaten up.

For instance, David had passed most of the audition for kingship in the first phase – His Father's House. There was a tougher second phase in The Palace of Saul. In the palace, it all started like he was the real star boy but before he could blink his eyes, scheming and plots to kill him began. There was an open display of hatred for him at a point.

How on earth would you keep on playing music for the man who wants you dead? He even threw a javelin at you once. He sent men to your house to bring you dead or alive even though you are his son-in-law. He wiped out an entire clan of priests simply because they gave you bread and a sword (the priests gave you the honour you deserve as an envoy but they paid with their lives and those of their wives and children)

If you get the opportunity to revenge, would you not seize the moment? Yes, you likely would. David was tempted to seize the moment. It was his test.

When he cut a piece of King Saul's garment, his conscience would not let him rest. That is the kind of heart that passes the audition for greatness.

David still called King Saul, "My father". David still showed honour. His men would have wondered why he was not seizing the moment.

"God has surely handed your enemy over to you this time!" Abishai whispered to David. "Let me pin him to the ground with one thrust of the spear; I won't need to strike twice!" "No!" David said. "Don't kill him. For who can remain innocent after attacking the Lord's anointed one? Surely the Lord will strike Saul down someday, or he will die of old age or in battle. The Lord forbid that I should kill the one he has anointed! But take his spear and that jug of water beside his head, and then let's get out of here!"
1 Samuel 26:8-11 NLT

Some opportunities will look like the perfect clapback moment or the time of vengeance. If you look closely, you will see your examiner standing close by. Most times, it is a test of your heart.

Can you speak a blessing over someone who has hurt you deeply? You cannot go up while you exert effort trying to hold somebody down.

What you are doing is purchasing your freedom from the poisoned arrows that can mar you for life. Once you respond with love and walk in honour, you have left the track that the poisoned arrow is travelling on. Poison does not travel on the highway of love and honour. There is no way you would meet. If you stay in bitterness, the arrow will pierce your heart and you will not like who you become.

Interestingly, this Father in the faith got to hear about what I did and blessed me with more than triple of what I brought to him as a seed. I was shocked.

First, never stop appreciating people from whom and places from where you have learnt major lessons in life. Take a review and find a way to say Thank You. Grateful people are scarce. Most people say Thank you in their hearts but never express it as an action. Out of the ten lepers who were cleansed, only one came back to say Thank You.

Gratitude is scarce. Do not become part of the statistics of ungrateful people. Outsiders, at times, are more grateful than insiders. The only leper who returned to say Thank You to Jesus was a Samaritan. Most pastors are better honoured outside their churches. Turn the table with you. Say thank you today to your pastor.

Second, it is very rare to outgive fathers. God gave us Jesus Christ. We can never outgive that. It is impossible. Abraham gave all he had to Isaac. That record cannot be beaten by whatever Isaac has to offer. Fathers will always outgive you. Do not hold back when you have opportunities to give to a teacher and

father. Do it well. Do it without expecting a thing in return. Just say Thank You.

Honour would always give birth to honour. Gifts open the door of access to the heart of kings. Most people hang around kings thinking of what to get. When you hang around a king, please think about what you can give and contribute. That is the password into greater and deeper realms. Be a giver.

Honour your teachers.

Remember the charge of Paul to Timothy:

Give double honour to spiritual leaders who handle their duties well. This is especially true if they work hard at teaching the word of God.
1 Timothy 5:17 GW

Who would you love to say “Thank You” to today?

There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, and so we were in their sight."

Numbers 13:32-33 NKJV

Their perceived status led them to small-mindedness. They said, "We are not able".

But the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we."

Numbers 13:31 NKJV

But as for Caleb who had an exceptional mind, his thought was different. His mind captured the victory. He told the people, "We are well able"

Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it."Numbers 13:30 NKJV

When I got into ministry in Eruwa, there was one person I was scared of meeting. Why? I was not sure how he would take it when I told him that I had decided to abandon legal practice so I could serve the Lord full-time in ministry. Truly, I was scared.

As destiny would have it, I ran into him one evening heading home from work. There was no escape route. I had to spill the beans that day. This beloved cerebral visionary looked at me and said:

"Temi, a lot of people may not understand the decision you have made. They will likely call you names like stupid, foolish, or zealous for nothing. Do not mind them all". I was surprised. He then added, "When I was coming to Eruwa thirty-three years ago (as it then was), all my mates thought I was mad. But 33 years down the line, none of them have a better legacy than I do". It was a liberating conversation. I left him with wings ready to fly.

Beloved, greatness comes with huge demands. You must know what you want. You must know what to ignore. There are times it is painful but you must trudge on in faith. Sometimes, those who are closest to you may not even understand the purpose or vision you are running with.

Do you know we are the ones who read about Jesus Christ and see the awe of all that he did? For a long time, his family did not believe in what he did. There is a particular episode that sends shivers down my spine every time. They told Jesus that he was beside himself (simply put, he was acting insane). Reading it in my language (Yoruba) got me scared.

Then Jesus went home, but once again a large crowd gathered around him, which prevented him from even eating a meal. When his own family heard that he was there, they went out to seize him, for they said, "He's

insane!"

Mark 3:20-21 TPT

While he was pursuing his vision and running after the assignment, his family called him 'insane'.

It was not just the only time. There was a time when his brothers told him that if he knew that he could do miracles, he should have shown himself to the world.

For no one does anything in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If you do these things, show Yourself to the world." For even His brothers did not believe in Him.

John 7:4-5 NKJV

If you stop to attend to all situations, you will never become great. You must know what to ignore. You must know that there are some answers that only the future can give. Let the vision that speaks at the end settle the contention. The siblings of Jesus Christ eventually became a part of the early church.

It is not for kings, O Lemuel, to guzzle wine. Rulers should not crave alcohol. For if they drink, they may forget the law and not give justice to the oppressed. Alcohol is for the dying, and wine for those in bitter distress. Proverbs 31:1-6 NLT

You are a king but the question is "What is distracting you?"

Pay attention to those who have gone ahead. Find out about their sacrifices. You will not be expected to pay less.

We agree the Lord will do it but most times, it is a quick cover-up for the inability to process an issue till you get to a point of light. It is a cover-up for mediocrity.

There are Christian meetings that are bereft of an excellent spirit. Why? They gave excuses while planning. They believe a miracle would just happen.

As a matter of fact, thinking is hard work and few people engage in it. If you have been to a meeting where you see the organisers running around at the last minute, you already know that poor thinking was in the background.

Listen, your mind must be fruitful. Engage it. Think through things. Process issues. Look at matters circumspectly. Paul advocated that:

Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you

to do.
Ephesians 5:17 NLT

Therefore, do not be vague and thoughtless and foolish, but understanding and firmly grasping what the will of the Lord is.
Ephesians 5:17 AMPC

God wants you to engage your mind. Take time to meditate on that idea, that issue or that business plan or that ambition. Do not use "Christianese" to excuse yourself. Think through and break through.

Those who think before execution get the highest rewards. Those who act without thinking always sweat and get little or no reward for their labour.

When Lot chose as regards the lovely land he saw (as he was about to separate from Abram), the scriptures let us know that he settled near Sodom.

***So, Abram settled in the land of Canaan, and Lot moved his tents to a place near Sodom and settled among the cities of the plain.
Genesis 13:12 NLT***

He was not in Sodom. He was living near Sodom. However, by the time, God would make a move to judge Sodom and Gomorrah, Lot was already living in Sodom.

***That evening the two angels came to the entrance of the city of Sodom. Lot was sitting there, and when he saw them, he stood up to meet them. Then he welcomed them and bowed with his face to the ground.
Genesis 19:1 NLT***

He was not just living in Sodom, his daughters had prospective husbands from the land. He was so mixed with Sodom that he was going to miss Sodom. He even chose to settle in a town closer to Sodom when God rescued him from there.

There are choices you can make that can look like “Near Sodom”. To fall into a pit, you must be close to the pit.

If you love to counsel the opposite sex alone in questionable places and at questionable times, remember that to fall into a pit, you must be close to the pit.

If you love receiving gifts from all and sundry under the guise of “I did not ask for it”, remember that to fall into a pit, you must be close to it.

If you love endearments and the emotional adrenaline that comes from the attention you get from the opposite sex, remember that to fall into a pit, you must be close to it.

If you see no need to set boundaries with spiritual daughters or sons as the case may be you go out alone with them on ministrations. They now can hug Daddy with such ease. Remember that to fall into a pit, you must be close to it.

You have no business being near Sodom. Deal with it now before it wrecks your reputation and worse still tarnishes the image of the kingdom of God.

PLACES YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO STAY – Micah's Shrine

Text: Philippians 3:19 NIV

Their destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach, and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is set on earthly things

I was having a conversation with a minister a while back and I realised that every one of his thoughts and words revolved around money. It was simply about the physical attractions of ministry. I had to warn myself that I would never be like that.

A dear teacher once said that a minister of the gospel has no business having a desire to be wealthy. Tough words. What is the point? Your focus must be contentment. Paul charged Timothy the same way:

These people always cause trouble. Their minds are corrupt, and they have turned their backs on the truth. To them, a show of godliness is just a way to become wealthy. Yet true godliness with contentment is itself great wealth.

1 Timothy 6:5-6 NLT

Then he pointed Timothy to Contentment again:

After all, we brought nothing with us when we came into the world, and we can't take anything with us when we leave it. So, if we have enough food and clothing, let us be content.

1 Timothy 6:7-8 NLT

However, in the Old Testament, there was a young Levite who took on the work of ministry. The ministry he joined was a shrine:

Micah set up a shrine for the idol, and he made a sacred ephod and some household idols. Then he installed one of his sons as his personal priest.

Judges 17:5 NLT

He took on the work because he wanted to survive. His concern was the shelter and the salary:

One day a young Levite, who had been living in Bethlehem in Judah, arrived in that area. "Where are you from?" Micah asked him. He replied, "I am a Levite from Bethlehem in Judah, and I am looking for a place to live." "Stay here with me," Micah said, "and you can be a father and priest

to me. I will give you ten pieces of silver a year, plus a change of clothes and your food."

Judges 17:7, 9-10 NLT

Some men came along and noticed that there was something different about him:

So, the men of Dan chose from their clans five capable warriors from the towns of Zorah and Eshtaol to scout out land for them to settle in. When these warriors arrived in the hill country of Ephraim, they came to Micah's house and spent the night there. While at Micah's house, they recognized the young Levite's accent, so they went over and asked him, "Who brought you here, and what are you doing in this place? Why are you here?"

Judges 18:2-3 NLT

Did you notice their questions: Who brought you here? What are you doing in this place? Why are you here?

The first question pointed to the place of covering and counsel. If you are well-trained and guided, there are places you will never be found. The second question may seem like it is asking for a job description but no! It is a statement of shock. And the final one was a question of when the purpose is defined, there are things you will never settle for.

This young Levite was simply in it for money. If you are called to ministry and you see that money is making the decisions now, you need to repent and retrace your steps before it is too late.

REFUSE TO GET INTO UNNECESSARY COMPETITIONS

Text: 2 Corinthians 10:12 NIV

We do not dare to classify or compare ourselves with some who commend themselves. When they measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves, they are not wise

As we walked towards the car that evening, Olive ran ahead to the car. As we got to the car, she called out to her sister and me, saying, "I got to the car first." Danielle's response was simple but profound. She said to her, "I am not in competition with you."

If you will overcome distraction, you must get rid of that strange pattern of unhealthy competition. It is absolutely unnecessary. Once a man is overwhelmed with competing, there are things he will lose sight of.

Let's begin with Adam and Eve trying hard to become like God when they were already made in the image of God. They lost everything in trying hard to become who they were already. When their eyes opened, they were already stripped naked.

How about Cain? He was blinded by competition. Instead of asking Abel what he did that made him excel in the sight of God, he resorted to competitive jealousy. He killed Abel. There are many fighting those they should be seeking answers from. There is a generation that kills their "Abels." Do not get distracted by competition.

Competition can be a significant distraction. The unhealthy competition between Leah and Rachel concerning their husband, Jacob, serves as a stark example. The lengths to which individuals will go to assert their superiority over others is evident in this narrative. They resorted to offering their maidservants to Jacob in a desperate attempt to gain an advantage. This behavior is deplorable and ultimately leads to negative consequences. In their case, it resulted in a fragmented family, culminating in the sons of Leah selling the son of Rachel into slavery. Have you considered the underlying motivations behind the names they chose for their children? A review of these names is recommended.

This is the motive for Reuben: ***"So Leah became pregnant and gave birth to a son. She named him Reuben, for she said, 'The Lord has noticed my misery, and now my husband will love me.'***"

Genesis 29:32 NLT

For Simeon: "The Lord heard that I was unloved and has given me another son."

Genesis 29:33 NLT

For Levi: "Surely this time, my husband will feel affection for me since I have given him three sons!"

Genesis 29:34 NLT

For Judah, She eventually decided to praise God: "Now I will praise the Lord!"

Genesis 29:35 NLT

But that praise and thanksgiving short-lived the moment she got into competition with Rachael again.

Rachael gave her maid to Jacob, and when the second son landed, she could not hide the competition:

Welcome Naphtali: ***"Rachel named him Naphtali, for she said, 'I have struggled hard with my sister, and I'm winning!'"***

Genesis 30:8 NLT

Leah fell into the trap and abandoned her praise to God to get her housemaid into the game also:

"Meanwhile, Leah realized that she wasn't getting pregnant anymore, so she took her servant, Zilpah, and gave her to Jacob as a wife."

Genesis 30:9 NLT

It is a strange cycle. This is not how God ordained you to live. You do not need the latest gadgets to prove a point to anyone. Calm down. Be secure in who God has made you. Life is a journey. Be patient. Stop unnecessary competition

NEVER SAY WITH PASSION WHAT YOU ARE MEANT TO SAY WITH WISDOM

Text: Proverbs 12:18 NIV

The words of the reckless pierce like swords, but the tongue of the wise brings healing

We were having a friendly talk over dinner when we remembered an incident that happened. We had a bad generator and Irewamiri was not happy about it. I told her that night, "Do not let it get at you. Let's rejoice in the middle of it all". We had a good laugh when we remembered how quickly matters degenerated into a disagreement.

In retrospect, we concluded that what is meant to be said with wisdom must never be said with passion. Passion is good. Wisdom is better. It is not the energy that is needed but the result that is required.

Never say with passion what you are meant to say with wisdom. Communication is not just about what is said but about how it is said and when it is said.

If you are strategic with words, you can get what others struggle to have. Daniel made us know that there is such a thing as speaking with tact.

Then Daniel returned an answer which was full of prudence and wisdom to Arioch the captain or executioner of the king's guard, who had gone forth to slay the wise men of Babylon.
Daniel 2:14 AMPC

The answer Daniel gave saved his life and bought him more time to find a solution to the crisis in the kingdom. Good intentions wrapped in unwise words will lead to disaster. Watch how you speak.

There were two prophets who delivered messages of correction and warning to kings. The situation was similar. They had both taken another man's wife. One even killed the husband to cover his tracks.

Prophet Nathan went to King David and he got the king to repent of his hideous act. He became a regular part of the king's decisions from then.

Then David confessed to Nathan, "I have sinned against the Lord." Nathan replied, "Yes, but the Lord has forgiven you, and you won't die for this sin."

2 Samuel 12:13 NLT

John the Baptist spoke to King Herod about Herodias. He ended up in prison and eventually, he was beheaded.

For Herod had arrested and imprisoned John as a favour to his wife Herodias (the former wife of Herod's brother Philip). John had been telling Herod, "It is against God's law for you to marry her."

Matthew 14:3-4 NLT

Even when you have a message from heaven that is burning heavily in your heart, it is important to ask God for wisdom to deliver it to your generation. Passion must not replace wisdom.

Nathan delivered a bitter truth in the capsule of a parable. David sentenced himself with his mouth. John the Baptist said the truth definitely but the reaction of the king was different yet the king was actually afraid of the popularity of John.

Herod wanted to kill John, but he was afraid of a riot because all the people believed John was a prophet.

Matthew 14:5 NLT

Passion is great. However, never say with passion what you are meant to say with wisdom.

PREPARE FOR OPPORTUNITIES BEFORE THEY COME

Text: Proverbs 16:1 NLT

We can make our own plans, but the LORD gives the right answer.

A protege reached out to me and said, “Pastor, we need to open a domiciliary account. Some people may want to give to you in foreign currencies to support the work”. I felt a bit bad but promised to work on it. I had the opportunity to open one earlier but ended up not pushing through at that moment.

Years ago, when we used to collect rainwater, if we were leaving the house, we positioned buckets at the edge of the roof so we could have some water if it rained. We also had water channels for gathering water running from the roof into big drums or tanks. We had not yet seen the rain, but we were always prepared.

Life is about preparations. The fact that you have not seen it does not mean you should not prepare for it.

Faith is also about preparations. The fact that it is not yet seen does not mean it does not exist. You must begin to prepare for what you desire.

Now faith is the assurance (title deed, confirmation) of things hoped for (divinely guaranteed) and the evidence of things not seen [the conviction of their reality—faith comprehends as fact what cannot be experienced by the physical senses].

Hebrews 11:1 AMP

Most young people will always say they want a God-fearing person and they add a long list of other qualities they desire. The question is when it rains, are your buckets already outside? That is, do you have the same qualities that you are looking for? If not, it is just a mere wish.

If you are trusting God for enlargement, you must be extending your territory and creating room for more.

Clear lots of ground for your tents! Make your tents large. Spread out! Think big! Use plenty of rope, drive the tent pegs deep...” Isaiah 54:2.

If you want a job in a multinational, are you following those working there also on Social Media platforms? Do you check to see the requirements that the company is putting out? Or are you lost in irrelevant platforms engaging in unproductive things?

No matter how much the pastor prophesies over you, a prophecy that interacts with preparation is the one that leads to a promotion.

If you desire a promotion, work for the new level that you desire. Do not do the work of a manager and expect the post of a senior manager. Do your best. Over-deliver.

Keep the buckets out. It will rain. If possible, build a reservoir. If you can, dig a well. Be prepared for your opportunities. Your preparation can end up creating your opportunities.

It was a joke, but truly, a marriage will struggle where one party understands covenant while the other party just knows convenience- a Christian marriage must be founded on the covenant.

The marriage covenant, in simplicity, is a binding agreement between a man and a woman who are legally and spiritually joined together as husband and wife. When a covenant is not understood, marriage is always abused.

Think about the word "binding". First, in a construction site, the concrete is made up of different materials. It is made up of sand and gravel, with water and cement serving as the binding agents. It goes through a process of hydration, which hardens it up to a single stone-like structure. Is there a way to separate all those materials and still retain them as whole single units? It is not possible. It

will be a total mess.

It is the same way when the Bible says that a man and his wife have become one:

Matthew 19:6 NKJV

So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate."

You are no longer two. You are one. You cannot hurt your spouse and not injure yourself in the covenant. You cannot beat the concrete wall and say, "It is only the sand I am beating and not the gravel". It is impossible. You cannot look down on your spouse and think you will rise. No!

Do you know the motto of one of the unions in the country? An injury to one is an injury to all! That is exactly what the marriage covenant is. You cannot injure one without the other.

There is no truly happy husband of a sad wife, and there is no truly happy wife of a sad husband. That is how powerful the covenant is.

Did you see that?

THE MARRIAGE COVENANT (2) – NO EMPTY WORDS

Text: Proverbs 5:18 NIV

May your fountain be blessed, and may you rejoice in the wife of your youth.

At a wedding some years back, as the exchange of vows was going on, it got to a portion where the groom seemed to mumble the words through. The presiding minister immediately scolded him and asked him to repeat the vows properly. He struggled through, but he eventually did. He must have known the weight of the words that he was saying.

When people exchange vows at the altar, they do not always seem to pay attention to them – they are too excited to think deeply about what they have said. Words are not a joke; vows are not just mere words.

These are the prophetic words of Malachi about this matter:

Malachi 2:13-14 AMPC

And this you do with double guilt; you cover the altar of the Lord with tears [shed by your unoffending wives, divorced by you that you might take heathen wives], and with [your own] weeping and crying out because the Lord does not regard your offering any more or accept it with favor at your hand. [14] Yet you ask, Why does He reject it? Because the Lord was witness [to the covenant made at your marriage] between you and the wife of your youth, against whom you have dealt treacherously and to whom you were faithless. Yet she is your companion and the wife of your covenant [made by your marriage vows].

First, God was a witness to the covenant made at your marriage. Second, that covenant was made by your marriage vows. This tells you something very simple: Words made your marriage. Words can break your marriage.

Let us ask some simple questions based on the marriage vows you made:

– Do you love him like you said you would?

– Do you still honour, cherish and submit to him as you vowed?

– Is your body really her own?

– Is your body really his own?

– Did you really leave your father and mother, or are they still controlling you as a couple?

– Have you really joined yourself to your wife?

– Are you standing with your spouse in all kingdom values?

– Are you standing together against everything not of God, or is there an entry created by a party already?

– Are you still in this for life?

Do you know who the Psalmist described as a righteous man?

Psalm 15:1,4 NIV

LORD, who may dwell in your sacred tent? Who may live on your holy mountain?... who keeps an oath even when it hurts, and does not change their mind.

Have you started changing your mind? How do you keep such strong vows? It is simple- Ask for the help of the Lord. Submit to the leading of the Holy Spirit. Stay humble and willing to learn. He gives grace to the humble.

Go back and check the vows you made? Ask yourself- did I speak mere words? Am I keeping my words or breaking them?

Text: John 2:5 NKJV

His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it."

During their courtship season, he said to his fiancée, "In this marriage, I will not have an opinion, and you will not have an opinion; we go with what the Word of the Lord says. If it cannot be found and justified in the Word, we will not do it". They have an amazing marriage that has run for over two decades today.

Another beloved one said to his wife, "The moment you show me in the Word of God, I will do it no matter how hard it is to obey". They both also have a great marriage.

A covenant marriage is one that is built on the foundation of God's Word. If you can both agree that the Word of the Lord is the foundation of your marriage and not social media, science or even common sense, you will surely do well.

Jesus shared a powerful lesson about the house built on sand and the one built on the rock.

"Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock. "But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall."

Matthew 7:24-27 NKJV

What did Jesus call wisdom here? Hearing and obeying the Word of God. People want to build marriages that will withstand storms, floods, and winds, yet disregard the Word of the Lord. It cannot work. You cannot follow social media and expect a home built on scriptures.

There is a lot of witchcraft packaged as wisdom being released systematically into the airwaves and the lives of people today. There are teachings that are mixed with hurt, offence, and pain, packaged as wisdom. If you are not rooted in the Word, you will practice what is shared, and you will be uprooted from your marriage.

When one spouse follows the scriptures and the other does not, that union cannot last. In the midst of issues, share scriptures instead of social media posts. Be submitted to the Word first. Stop looking for justification for your position.

May your marriage be strong.

THE DANGER OF “DISTANCE”

Text: Proverbs 27:17 NLT

As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend.

When we were done talking that day, he said to me, “Thank you for calling me, sir. I have been feeling very far, and I do not know what to do about it. This call has made a whole lot of difference.”

A relationship is serviced by communication. If you are not intentional with communicating, you will realize that intimacy begins to wane. If you do not become deliberate about prayer and study of the Word, your relationship with God will drop in quality.

I have had relationships that died a “natural death” because of the communication gap that was built. One of the things that begins to happen is that you realize that the longer it takes to reach out to such persons, the harder it becomes to reach out. Quality relationships can be lost to such patterns.

There are relationships you must never allow to wane- you must always give it your best. When the devil also wants to destroy a man, he ensures that he is far from voices that can hold him accountable and caution him in trouble.

The trouble of Samson did not begin with Delilah. Not at all! It began the day he started withholding important information from his parents. When he killed the lion, he said nothing. It was easier to go back to the same place to draw honey and lick it. It is always a “gradual” decline till it becomes a mess.

You are blessed when people who should hold you accountable still come into your space to encourage or warn you. There are times when it can be an uncomfortable conversation. It can be about a pattern of

behaviour that they have noticed. Take it humbly as great feedback. Work on it!

No matter how busy I am, there are relationships that I will never take for granted, and there are places and meetings that are a must for me. Why? They are voices of rectitude. They are places of instruction. They are people who stir me to deeper things.

If there are calls you must make today, do not postpone them till tomorrow. I ran into a dear one once. She was in shock. I was excited to see her. She kept apologizing about how distant she had been. I led her to Christ and disciplined her as a young convert. Over time, there were patterns that I saw that were not Christ-like. That is part of the strategy of distance. For some seeds to grow in your life, there are some people from whom the enemy will isolate you.

I know another person who also stopped going to church for months. I just did not love the gradual slope I was seeing with her moral standard. I knew something was wrong. Distance is a devilish trap when your spiritual health is concerned. Maybe you should wake up! Make that call today. Build that relationship again today. It is already dying. Go and water it.

Text: Psalm 89:1 NIV

Adonijah was plotting to become the king even though David was not yet dead. Bathsheba had a promise already from King David that her son, Solomon would be King after him.

Nathan the prophet was the one who gave the needed push for Bathsheba to go into the King. Even though Bathsheba had a sure word from the King, the first thing that she did when she got to the King was not to throw the weight of the words around. No! She did something we should all learn to do. She worshipped.

"Bathsheba went to the king in his private room. The king was very old, and Abishag from Shunem was taking care of him. Bathsheba knelt and bowed down in front of the king. "What do you want?" the king asked." 1 Kings 1:15-16 GW

Text: Jeremiah 33:3 NKJV

Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.

Many years ago, my spiritual father was preaching in the city of Uyo, Akwa-Ibom State, Nigeria. I was in the congregation. There was no way he would know I was there. It was a church with a heavy protocol system.

I succeeded in catching his attention before he left the auditorium. He was surprised to see me. He held me by the hand and every door that opened for him opened for me also. No one could stop me.

A believer who refuses to connect to all of Heaven's power resources by praying will be the one who will be stranded on earth.

In teaching us what is now called the Lord's prayer, Jesus made it clear that there is a will of heaven that can be enforced on earth by men who are willing to pray.

For instance, there had been no access to the king for 30 days and you cannot go to the king without an invitation. If you do, you will be killed. Esther had to take a risk. But she first summoned the nation of Israel to prayers:

"All the king's advisers and the people in the king's provinces know that no one approaches the king in the throne room without being summoned. By law, that person must be put to death. Only if the king holds out the golden sceptre to him will he live. I, myself, have not been summoned to enter the king's presence for 30 days now." "Assemble all the Jews in Susa. Fast

for me: Do not eat or drink at all for three entire days. My servants and I will also fast. After that, I will go to the king, even if it is against a royal decree. If I die, I die."

Esther 4:11, 16 GW

Esther approached the king by faith. What raised the King's sceptre? Do you think it was the beauty of Esther? I doubt it! That beauty did not work for thirty days. It was the force of prayer backing up that decision.

There will be doors that will remain shut if we do not know how to connect to our source.

The Apostle John made us know that greater is he that is in us than he that is in the world.

Smith Wigglesworth said, 'I am a thousand times bigger on the inside than I am on the outside'.

When everything around you seems to make you feel small, stay calm. It is making a demand on what is within you. Press into prayer. Connect with heaven's unlimited resources. There are angels on standby. There is the anointing. There is the grace of the Lord. You cannot be stranded.

Text: Proverbs 22:29 GW

Do you see a person who is efficient in his work? He will serve kings. He will not serve unknown people.

A dear sister of mine narrated how she got a call from the White House. She laughed and thought it was a scam. They had to use other means to reach her eventually. Her competence earned her a seat with the President of the most powerful nation on earth.

Competence has a voice and it speaks loudly. If you are praying for open doors to palaces, make sure you are also building competence behind the scenes. A lot of people who pray for open doors have not honed their skills.

Let us see examples of the requirements from palaces:

In the days of Daniel and the three Hebrew boys who ended up as top officials in Babylon, there was a published requirement.

"They were to be young men who were healthy, good-looking, knowledgeable in all subjects, well-informed, intelligent, and able to serve in the king's palace. They were to be taught the language and literature of the Babylonians."

Daniel 1:4 GW

Can you see areas to work to become attractive to kings: Are you strong and healthy? How good do you look or do you belong to the "I don't care" gang or the female version of "Who is looking at me?", How many subjects can you take on confidently? Are you aware of global developments?

Maybe the standard there was too high, let's see what was said of David when Saul had a vacancy in the palace staff that must be filled- His Personal Assistant of Emotional

Restoration.

See the Curriculum Vitae of young David who got the appointment:

Saul told his officials, "Please find me a man who can play well and bring him to me." One of the officials said, "I know one of Jesse's sons from Bethlehem who can play well. He's a courageous man and a warrior. He has a way with words, he is handsome, and the Lord is with him."

1 Samuel 16:17-18 GW

Wait, what is a skill or area in which you excel and perform proficiently? Does your communication reflect sophistication, or is it merely casual?

Some individuals express a desire to be introduced to a specific person. Upon introduction, will you be able to deliver your message competently, or will you simply depart with a photograph for social media?

Joseph was presented to Pharaoh because of his competence and proven ability to deliver. Furthermore, his appearance was always appropriate and well-considered.

That customer you treated badly can be twenty referrals lost. Develop competence. Pray. Build your competence also.

HOW TO GET ACCESS 4 (THE POWER OF GIFTS)

Text: Proverbs 11:24 NKJV

There is one who scatters, yet increases more; And there is one who withholds more than is right, But it leads to poverty

We were in a conference where the speaker made a reference to how a relationship I connected them with in the city they are in has blessed them tremendously. I began to meditate about how I got into that relationship with a dear father:

I returned from a speaking engagement and met his wife in Eruwa. I had not heard from this father in years. I heard he was now a Bishop. I sent a gift to him. It was a necktie that I was given as an honorarium. He was so amazed. Today, I have a perpetual open door in his home and I can say in his heart.

Friends, gifts are door openers. Jesus lamented once that the children of the world are smarter in their ways than the sons of the kingdom.

“Worldly people are more clever than spiritually-minded people when it comes to dealing with others.” Luke 16:8 GW

Why? The children of the world know the power of access to men of influence. They would use bribes. We have something greater than bribes. We have love. We have wisdom. We must learn to deploy both.

The scriptures spoke about how profanely powerful a bribe can be. Bribes can pervert judgement. We have seen this play out in corrupt systems at times. ***“A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of***

judgment.”
Proverbs 17:23 KJV

“And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.” 1 Samuel 8:3 KJV

However, when you have built relationships and invested in relationships, things that are meant to work in your disfavour can turn out for your good.

Gifts can turn away anger also:
“Try giving a secret gift to the one who is angry with you and watch his anger disappear. A kind, generous gift goes a long way to soothe the anger of one who is livid.”
Proverbs 21:14 TPT

You will be limited in life even if you are a prayer warrior but your relationship with men is terrible – The prophecy of Elisha can help the widow but her relationship with her sons and her neighbours was also a leverage. You must never joke with people.

Be a giver also.

LIVE IN FORGIVENESS

Text: Luke 6:37 NKJV

Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

I was teaching a class a while back. When we touched on the subject of forgiveness and why it was important, a young man took a deep sigh and shared his journey:

His father was not the perfect role model. He was a pain to his family. He would get drunk and act in strange ways. The son said he hated the dad's actions. But he made a discovery that day in class. Even though he hated the dad's actions, he was already slipping into the same pattern.

Why? The one who locks a man in prison cannot be far from the prison also. The one who keeps a man down would also have to stay down. He admitted that he was already manifesting the tendencies of his father. That day, he decided to forgive his dad.

Forgiveness is one of God's unique systems of protection. The provocation of men is a temptation. If you do not handle it wisely, it will become a trap for your soul.

Jesus told Peter to forgive as much as possible:

Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven.
Matthew 18:21-22 NKJV

A Christian brother hated his dad. His dad abused his mother. He would at

times beat her up. He hated the man. He had a word from the Lord to forgive but he refused.

When he got married, he began to show the exact patterns of his dad. He was shocked but he was still proud. He ended up marrying a second and third wife. He would chase out one and marry another. He became worse than the man he refused to forgive.

Beloved, the provocation of men is a trap. When Jesus taught the Lord's prayer, coming right after forgiveness was deliverance from temptation.

and forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us. And don't let us yield to temptation, but rescue us from the evil one.
Matthew 6:12-13 NLT

If you do not live in forgiveness, you will soon yield to temptation and you leave your life open for the evil one to come in and exit at will. Unforgiveness is the turf where the devil plays his game. Do not play that game with him. Refuse it. Walk the high road of honour and obedience to the will of God.

LET IT END WITH YOU

Text: Ephesians 4:27 ESV

And give no opportunity to the devil.

I was walking down the staircase in Fajuyi Hall during my university days. A young man suddenly ran into me from the back forcing me down the stairs. I struggled to maintain a balance. When I got my stability, I turned around and smiled at him asking if he was not injured in any way or if he was fine. I continued my walk.

The young man ran after me and said, "Who are you please?" I still smiled and wondered why he asked. He then said, "I left my room angry. I was looking for who to provoke so I could transfer the anger. I am shocked you did not get angry. Please, who are you?" I smiled at him again. I walked away leaving him in his awe.

Beloved, you are a conduit of divine things. Refuse the devil the permission to use you as a means to transfer anything ungodly. You only carry and transfer godly things. Let nothing that is not of the Lord have a space to flow through you.

The devil needs vessels to transfer his product. Do not let him transport anger or lust or bitterness or envy or jealousy or hurting words through you. Do not become a borrowed vessel.

If you allow the devil to transport his products through you, you would lose divine things. For instance, anytime he succeeds in using you as a borrowed vessel for anger, you will lose peace. If he uses you as a vessel to transport lust, you have lost self-control. If he uses you to transfer hatred, you have lost love. If

he uses you to transfer bitterness, you will lose joy or even kindness. Refuse it. Be a conduit of divine things only.

Now, you have to stop telling yourself that "Someone made you do it". The remote control of your emotions is not in their hands. Does it mean when they press "angry", you just get angry? Tell yourself: the remote control of my emotions is not with anyone. I choose divine response.

If a man is carrying water in his cup and I bump into him, it cannot spill oil. It will spill what he carries. Carry an overflow of love and graceful speaking. If people bump into you at any time, let graciousness flow from you. You are the blessed of the Lord. You are a conduit of divine things.

Jesus did not pass on the hurting words they threw at him on the cross. It ended with him. He transmitted love. He did not pass on the pain of the betrayal of Judas or the desertion of those who promised to stand with him. He passed on blessings.

What has to end with you today? You are God's Ambassador. Refuse to be a spokesperson for hell.

ARE YOU TRACKABLE?

Text: 2 Kings 5:26 NKJV

Then he said to him, "Did not my heart go with you when the man turned back from his chariot to meet you?"

In the era just before mobile phones became popular, my mum travelled to see my sister at the university. She returned with great joy, and I heard as she shared with my Dad:

Upon arrival at the school, they went to look for her in her hostel. When they announced her name over the Public Address system, another student came out who was not her daughter. The Hostel Warden said she should be in the academic area, most likely the library.

They proceeded to the library. She described my Sister to the attendant, who said, "I think I know her. She came in some minutes ago. I know where she sits to read." He returned with her a few minutes later. Mum returned home so proud of her daughter.

Friends, one of the ways that you earn trust in life is by living a life of accountability.

Dear husband, can your wife say for sure where her husband is at per time? Do you know that when you come back home late, and you are questioned, you do not have to get angry? The response to that question is not "cover-up anger." She is asking because she is worried about you. But if you keep that pattern, she will soon start asking because trust is being eroded. If you refuse to change and she keeps quiet, you do not win at last. Perish that thought! You are already losing your wife and your marriage.

There are young ones who complain that their parents do not trust them. Have you forgotten that trust is earned? How will they trust you when you bolt your door behind like a strong room right under their roof? They have to wait for about three minutes before you get to the door. Do you know they have questions already?

Now you really think they will trust you when you say you are going to a place. Why? You have not earned it. Trust is earned.

If you are in a church family, you will also need to earn that trust. You cannot be trusted with responsibilities when you appear and disappear at will. Even your ministry head cannot speak about where you are. People who lose their place and trust always

begin with "hiding things." That was how Samson began his decline:

And the Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon him, and he tore the lion apart as one would have torn apart a young goat, though he had nothing in his hand. But he did not tell his father or his mother what he had done.

Judges 14:6 NKJV

From that singular action, his decline began. It was easier to return to the same place.

After some time, when he returned to get her, he turned aside to see the carcass of the lion. And behold, a swarm of bees and honey were in the carcass of the lion.

Judges 14:8 NKJV

He did not stop there. He was now comfortable eating honey from the dead carcass and also shared it:

He took some of it in his hands and went along, eating. When he came to his father and mother, he gave some to them, and they also ate. But he did not tell them that he had taken the honey out of the carcass of the lion.

Judges 14:9 NKJV

Embrace the culture of full disclosure. Do not say half-truths. Do not get lost in strategic rationalizing. There are times I would buy Irewamiri a gift, and she would ask, "Darling, where did you get the funds for this?" I have to say it all.

One of the ways to survive the devil's antics is to build a strong sense of accountability. Sin does not always start as sin. It begins with breaking codes of consecration. You will do things that are not sinful but are also not expected of you. If you are not confident to mention it, do not start it at all.

It will help you.
